designated §3-1-52, relating to establishing penalties for any delegate at a convention of 2

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL **PROVISIONS** AND **DEFINITIONS.** §3-1-52. Penalty for convention of states delegate who deviates from authority. Any delegate who attends a convention of states to modify the United States Constitution and who exceeds his or her authority at the convention is subject to mandatory, immediate recall, a 3 \$100,000 to \$500,000 fine, and up to 10 years in prison. Additionally, the delegate's vote or votes shall be void.

> NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish penalties for any delegate at a convention of states convention who deviates from his or her authority.
