- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §8-12-28, relating to authorizing municipalities to place signage on state roads
- 3 within their municipal jurisdiction and boundaries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 12. GENERAL AND SPECIFIC POWERS, DUTIES AND ALLIED RELATIONS OF MUNICIPALITIES, GOVERNING BODIES AND MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES; SUITS AGAINST MUNICIPALITIES.

§8-12-28.Authorizingmunicipalitiestoplacesignage.1Municipalities in this state are authorized to place signage on state roads within their2municipal jurisdiction and boundaries. Such signs may include, but are not limited to, speed3warning signs or radar-based signs that inform the driver of their speed.
