A BILL to amend and reenact §16-2-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 mobile food establishment reciprocity.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### CHAPTER 16. PUBLIC HEALTH.

#### ARTICLE 2. LOCAL BOARDS OF HEALTH.

#### §16-2-18. In-state food service permit reciprocity. In-state food service statewide permit.

(a) A local or county health department shall issue a mobile food establishment reciprocity
permit to a mobile food service establishment that is operating within the State of West Virginia
and holds a valid mobile food establishment permit from the vendor's county of residence. The
mobile food establishment reciprocity permit shall be valid for the length of time for which the first
permit is issued and regardless of the number of days for which the vendor requires the mobile
food establishment reciprocity permit.

7 (b) No A local or county health department within the state may not charge an additional a 8 fee to any an in-state vendor that has received a mobile food establishment reciprocity permit. but 9 may place conditions upon an issued permit to assure compliance with that health department's 10 rules and standards for the type of permit being issued. Each vendor must provide notice to the 11 local health department with jurisdiction at least 14 days prior to operating within the jurisdiction A 12 mobile food establishment in compliance with rules of the issuing local or county health 13 department is deemed in compliance in all other counties. The permit must shall be visibly posted 14 while the mobile food establishment is operational.

- (c) The secretary shall review and modernize legislative rules regarding local boards of
   health fees located in 64 CSR 30 in the next filing period
- 17 (a) A local or county health department shall issue a mobile food establishment statewide
- 18 permit to a mobile food service establishment that is operating within the State of West Virginia.
- 19 The permit will be issued from the vendor's county of residence local or county health department.

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20 The mobile food establishment statewide permit shall be valid for up to one year from the date 21 which the permit is issued and regardless of the number of days for which the vendor requires the 22 mobile food establishment. 23 (b) No local or county health department within the state may charge an additional fee to 24 any in-state vendor that has received a mobile food establishment statewide permit but may place 25 conditions upon an issued permit to assure compliance with that health department's rules and 26 standards for the type of permit being issued. Each vendor must provide notice to the local health 27 department with jurisdiction at least 72 hours prior to operating within the jurisdiction. A mobile 28 food establishment, in compliance with rules of the issuing local or county health department, is deemed in compliance in all other counties. The permit shall be visibly posted while the mobile 29
