 designated §20-2-65, relating to the creation of a three-year pilot program for the stocking
 of F1 largemouth bass fingerlings, otherwise known as "tiger bass."

- 23 (d) Length of program. The pilot program shall begin on July 1, 2024, for the one-time
- 24 stocking of 4,000 F1 largemouth bass fingerlings. On July 1, 2027, the division shall evaluate the
- 25 success of the program, and whether it should continue or cease.
