- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia,1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §18B-14-5, relating to requiring state institutions of higher education to accept
- 3 vaccine exemptions for religious, medical, or right or conscience.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 14. MISCELLANEOUS.

### §18B-14-5. State institutions of higher education shall accept religious, medical, or right of

### conscience exemptions to taking vaccinations.

1 <u>All state institutions of higher education shall accept vaccine exemptions for religious,</u>

### 2 medical, or right of conscience for any student attending or living on campus.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require state institutions of higher education universities to accept exemptions to vaccinations in addition to the medical exemptions.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
