1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §5A-12-15, relating to protecting gasoline-powered, state vehicles from  
3 government bans.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 12. FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION.**

**§5A-12-15. Protecting gas-powered vehicles from government bans.**

1 The government shall not create any law banning gasoline-powered, state vehicles nor  
2 shall it create any requirement that state vehicles be powered by any non-gasoline means.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to protect gasoline-powered, state vehicles from government bans.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
