A BILL to amend and reenact §39-4-20 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
exempting persons previously commissioned as a notary public from the requirement that
notary publics have a high school diploma or its equivalent in order to be recommissioned
as a notary public.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. REVISED LAW ON ACTS. UNIFORM NOTARIAL \$39-4-20. Commission as notary public: gualifications: no immunity or benefit: disposition of fees. 1 (a) An individual qualified under subsection (b) of this section may apply to the Secretary of 2 State for a commission as a notary public through the Secretary of State's online notary system. 3 The applicant shall comply with and provide the information required by rules promulgated by the 4 Secretary of State and pay any application fee. 5 (b) An applicant for a commission as a notary public must: 6 (1) Be at least 18 years of age; 7 (2) Be a citizen or permanent legal resident of the United States; 8 (3) Be a resident of or have a place of employment or practice in this state; 9 (4) Be able to read and write English; 10 (5) Have For any applicant that has not been commissioned as a notary prior to January 1, 11 2018, have a high school diploma or its equivalent; and 12 (6) Not be disqualified to receive a commission under §39-4-23 of this code. 13 (c) Before issuance of a commission as a notary public, an applicant shall provide a 14 statement on the notary application that they solemnly swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury, 15 that the answers to all questions in this application are true, complete, and correct; that he or she 16 has carefully read the notaries public law of West Virginia; and, if appointed and commissioned as 17 a notary public, he or she will perform faithfully, to the best of his or her ability all notarial acts in 18 accordance with the law.

- (d) On compliance with this section, the Secretary of State shall issue a commission as anotary public to an applicant for a term of five years.
- 21 (e) A commission to act as a notary public authorizes the notary public to perform notarial
- 22 acts. The commission does not provide the notary public any immunity or benefit conferred by law
- 23 of this state on public officials or employees.
