A BILL to amend and reenact §4-1-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
requiring that House of Delegates and the Senate open each session with the Pledge of
Allegiance to the Flag of West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 1. OFFICERS, MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES; APPROPRIATIONS; INVESTIGATIONS; DISPLAY OF FLAGS; <u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE</u> <u>FLAG OF WEST VIRGINIA;</u> RECORDS; USE OF CAPITOL BUILDING; PREFILING OF BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS; STANDING COMMITTEES; INTERIM MEETINGS; NEXT MEETING OF THE SENATE.
