A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article
designated §5B-2P-1, all relating to creating the "Work Protection Act" prohibiting a state
agency or local government from enacting or enforcing a universal basic income program.
*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

### **ARTICLE 2P. WORK PROTECTION ACT.**

- 5 (c) *Definitions*. As used in this section:
- 6 (1) "Local government" means a county; a municipality, an incorporated town, or a village;
- 7 or any other district or political subdivision of the state or an agency, board, or commission of the
- 8 district or political subdivision of the state;
- 9 (2) "State agency" means an office, board, commission, department, council, bureau, or
- 10 <u>other agency of state government;</u>
- 11 (3) "Universal basic income program" means a program that is not expressly required by
- 12 <u>federal law in which an individual receives a guaranteed cash payment regularly.</u>
- 13 (d) Prohibition on program. Unless expressly authorized by state law, a state agency or a
- 14 local government shall not enact or enforce, directly or indirectly, a universal basic income
- 15 program.
- 16 (e) *Effective date.* This act shall take effect upon passage.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create the Work Protection Act prohibiting a state agency or local government from enacting or enforcing a universal basic income program.

Strike-throughs language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
