1	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2	designated §31-15-7a, relating to requiring the Economic Development Authority to
3	transfer \$15,000,000 to the Wayne County Commission to be utilized to support the Crum
4	Public Service District in constructing a water treatment plant in southern Wayne County.
	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 15. WEST VIRGINIA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

§31-15-7a. Funding for Wayne County Commission for water infrastructure

- 1 (a) The Legislature finds that.
- 2 (1) Access to clean and reliable water supplies are critical to a high quality of life for our
- 3 <u>citizens as well as our outlook for economic growth. Legislature finds that economic conditions in</u>

4 <u>certain communities present acute obstacles to building and maintaining sufficient infrastructure to</u>

5 <u>ensure a modern standard of living for current and prospective residents;</u>

- 6 (2) The disruptions to water supplies of southern Wayne and northern Mingo Counties in
- 7 consecutive years 2023 and 2024 negatively impacted thousands of residents;
- 8 (3) The Crum PSD depends solely upon water supplies from Kermit Municipal Water and
- 9 the Mingo PSD, and that this dependence, while not the sole factor, is nevertheless a primary
- 10 <u>factor in the recurring service disruptions throughout the area;</u>
- 11 (4) The engineering report by E.L. Robinson which suggests construction of a water
- 12 treatment plant in southern Wayne County outlines a viable path toward more reliable water
- 13 <u>service for residents of the area;</u>
- 14 (5) Such a water treatment facility will reduce the burden on the Mingo PSD and Kermit
- 15 Municipal Water Company; and
- 16 (6) Such water infrastructure, being necessary to economic development, should qualify
- 17 for funding from the West Virginia Economic Development Authority, provided that the Wayne
- 18 County Commission establish a dedicated account to receive funds and implement the water plant

- 19 <u>infrastructure project.</u>
- 20 (b) As the cost identified with the project is estimated at \$15,000,000, the West Virginia
- 21 Economic Development Authority shall transfer \$15,000,000 to the Wayne County Commission to
- 22 be utilized to support the Crum Public Service District in constructing a water treatment plant in
- 23 southern Wayne County.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Economic Development Authority to transfer \$15,000,000 to the Wayne County Commission to be utilized to support the Crum Public Service District in constructing a water treatment plant in southern Wayne County.
