- 2 authorizing the Board of Examiners of Psychologists to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to disciplinary and complaint procedures for psychologists.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Examiners of Psychologists.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2023, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-21-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Examiners of Psychologists to meet
- the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register
- 4 on September 15, 2023, relating to the Board of Examiners of Psychologists (disciplinary and
- 5 complaint procedures for psychologists, 17 CSR 04), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners of Psychologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to disciplinary and complaint procedures for psychologists.
