1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to minimum  
 3 standards for election administration, infrastructure, and security.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Secretary of State.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2023, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §3-1A-6 of this code, modified by the Secretary of State to meet the objections of the  
 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 25, 2023,  
 4 relating to the Secretary of State (minimum standards for election administration, infrastructure,  
 5 and security, [153 CSR 55](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to minimum standards for election administration, infrastructure, and security.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
