- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Department of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 procedure to contest the substantiation of child abuse or neglect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

## §64-5-1. Department of Human Services.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 13, 2023, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §49-4-601b of this code, modified by the Department of Human Services to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 November 7, 2023, relating to the Department of Human Services (procedure to contest the
- 5 substantiation of child abuse or neglect, 78 CSR 27), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to procedure to contest the substantiation of child abuse or neglect.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
