1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction to
3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to protocol for law-enforcement response to domestic
4 violence.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the
2 authority of §48-27-1102 of this code, modified by the Governor's Committee on Crime,
3 Delinquency, and Correction to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 4, 2023, relating to the Governor's
5 Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction (protocol for law enforcement response to
6 domestic violence, [149 CSR 03](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to protocol for law enforcement response to domestic violence.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
