A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §18-2-30, relating to fentanyl abuse prevention and drug poisoning awareness
education in public schools; and establishing a Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week for
grades 6 through 12, to be known as Laken's Law.

- 24 (d) The instruction required by this section shall begin in the 2024-2025 school year.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish a Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week for grades 6 through 12., to be known as "Laken's Law", relating fentanyl abuse prevention and drug poisoning awareness education in public schools.
