1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §18-2-25f, relating to allowing students to participate in non-school activities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

### §18-2-25f. Participation in non-school activities.

- 1 (a) Legislative Intent- The Legislature of West Virginia makes the following findings:
- 2 (1) While participation in school sponsored extracurricular sports is a voluntary opportunity,
- 3 <u>no student-athlete should be deprived of additional opportunities to advance or showcase their</u>
- 4 <u>skills purely because they are playing for a school sports team.</u>
- 5 (2) Prohibiting a student-athlete from participating in non-school sponsored events or
- 6 activities as condition for participation on a school-sponsored team is unlawfully arbitrary and is
- 7 <u>not rationally related to a state purpose.</u>
- 8 (b) A county board of education and the West Virginia Secondary School Activities
- 9 Commission shall not restrict or prohibit a student from competing in non-school events or
- 10 participating on non-school competitive teams as a condition of playing for the same school
- 11 extracurricular activity or sport.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow student-athletes to participate in competitive events and activities while playing for their school.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
