





The rules to be repealed during the 2008 legislative session are 45CSR9, 45CSR12, 45CSR15 and 45CSR24.

The substantive portions of the rules to be repealed have been updated and included as revisions to agency-approved rules 45CSR8, 45CSR18, and 45CSR34, submitted to the Secretary of State's office on July 25 and 26, 2007. The content of rules 45CSR9 and 45CSR12 will be included in 45CSR8; the content of rule 45CSR15 will be included in 45CSR34; and the content of rule 45CSR24 will be included in 45CSR18.
