

Impact of Sequester on WV Head Start and Early Head Start





Head Start/Early Head Start

- Head Start/Early Head Start is a federal program that promotes the school readiness of children ages birth to 5 from low-income families by enhancing their cognitive, social and emotional development.
- Head Start/Early Head Start is a child-centered, family focused, comprehensive and community-based program.
- Head Start provides comprehensive education, health, nutrition, dental, mental health, social services and parent involvement opportunities to income eligible children and their families.



Snapshot of Head Start in WV

- 21 local agencies administering Head Start (HS) statewide.
- 9 of those programs also provide Early Head Start (EHS) in 23 counties.
- In 2011-2102, WV HS and EHS served 9,583 children across the state.

Why is EHS not statewide?

- Early Head Start is a much younger program, started in 1995. As a result, there are fewer EHS programs nationally.
- Funding is competitive and programs are awarded based upon strength of grant applications.



Impact of Sequester to HS/EHS

- The FY 13 sequester cuts to WV HS/EHS equaled \$3,127,159. (Source: WV Head Start Association Sequester Impact Survey)
- This has resulted in 461 fewer families receiving Head Start and Early Head Start services during this school year. (Source: National Head Start Association West Virginia Fact Sheet: Impact of Sequestration. Website: <u>www.nhsa.org</u>)
- 80 staff have also lost their jobs. (Source: WV Head Start Association Sequester Impact Survey)
- Head Start services have been diminished.
