1. That the Select Committee on Minority affairs used the Select Committee Report to guide their discussion over the next three months.
2. That the Select Committee on Minority Affairs send a letter to Governor Earl Ray Tomblin urging him to use the Select Committee on Minority Affairs Report to direct the efforts of the Herb Office of Minority Affairs.
3. That the Select Committee on Minority Affairs send a letter to Earl Ray Tomblin urging him to request funding for SB-573, HB-2950, SB-359-18-3-12, SB-611.
4. That the Select Committee on Minority Affairs adopted the West Side Revive as a Pilot Community to advance some of the recommendations in the Select Committee Report
5. That the Select Committee on Minority Affairs encourage the Governor's Office to adopt the West Side as a Pilot Community for Juvenile Justice Reform.
6. That the Committee on Children' Issues adopt the West Side of Charleston as a Pilot Community to address children's issue.
