The Joint Legislative Oversight Commission on State Water Resources met in the Senate Judiciary Committee Room at 10 a.m., Wednesday, February 12, 2014. Rich Ireland, Regional Sales Manager, Rosemount Tank Gauging, addressed the Commission and responded to questions regarding the American Petroleum Institute (API) 2350 guidelines.
