Pursuant to the call of Chairman Maroney, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources met on January 15, 2019 at 1:00 PM in the Senate Finance Room, 451-M.

Silent roll call was taken. There being eleven (11) members present, a quorum was established. Present were Chairman Maroney, Vice-Chairman Tarr, Senator Azinger, Senator Maynard, Senator Palumbo, Senator Plymale, Senator Prezioso, Senator Roberts, Senator Rucker, Senator Unger and Senator Weld.

Chairman Maroney recognized the Vice-Chair who introduced a motion to approve the minutes held January 10, 2019. The minutes were approved.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 170 DHHR rule relating to food establishments.

Counsel Dellinger responded to questions from the committee.

With leave of the committee, Judith Vallandingham, Division Director for the Public Health Sanitation Division with Bureau for Public Health, was administered the oath prescribed by Senate Rule 28a by Chairman Maroney, addressed the committee and responded to questions regarding SB 170.

Chairman Maroney recognized Vice-Chairman Tarr who moved that SB 170 be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the committee on the Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 171 DHHR rule relating to food manufacturing facilities.

Counsel Dellinger responded to questions from the committee.

Chairman Maroney recognized Vice-Chairman Tarr who moved that SB 175, as amended, be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the Committee on Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 176 DHHR rule relating to cooperative agreement approval and compliance.

Chairman Maroney recognized Vice-Chairman Tarr who moved that SB 176 be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the committee on the Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 168 DHHR rule relating to behavioral health centers.

Chairman Maroney recognized Vice-Chairman Tarr who moved that SB 168 be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the committee on the Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Vice-Chairman Tarr moved to adjourn. Chairman Maroney put the question on the motion. The motion passed.
