

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
SENATE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES

January 17, 2019

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Pursuant to the call of Chairman Maroney, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources met on January 17, 2019 at 1:00 PM in the Senate Finance Room, 451-M.

Silent roll call was taken. There being ten (10) members present, a quorum was established. Present were Chairman Maroney, Senator Azinger, Senator Maynard, Senator Palumbo, Senator Plymale, Senator Prezioso, Senator Roberts, Senator Rucker, Senator Stollings, and Senator Weld.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who introduced a motion to approve the minutes held January 15, 2019. The minutes were approved.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 169 DHHR rule relating to assisted living residences. Counsel Dellinger presented an amendment to SB 169.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who moved that the amendment to SB 169 be adopted. The Chairman put the question on the motion. The amendment was adopted.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who moved that SB 169, as amended, be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 136 relating to tobacco usage and e-cigarette restrictions. Senator Stollings addressed the committee with comments in favor of SB 136.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who moved that SB 136 be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 63 relating to partial filling of prescriptions. Counsel Dellinger presented a title amendment to SB63.

Counsel Dellinger responded to questions from the committee.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who moved that SB63 be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the committee on the Judiciary. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who moved that the Title Amendment to Senate Bill 63 be approved. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 310 establishing certain requirements for dental insurance. Counsel Dellinger offered a Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 310 and responded to questions from the committee.

With leave of the committee, Hallie Mason of Mason Consulting was administered the oath prescribed by Senate Rule 28a by Chairman Maroney, addressed the committee on behalf of the WV Dental Association and responded to questions regarding SB310.

Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Stollings who moved that the Committee Substitute for SB310 be reported with recommendation to pass and referred to the committee on Finance. The chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was passed.

SB300 was removed from the agenda and not discussed.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Senator Stollings moved to adjourn. Chairman Maroney put the question on the motion. The motion passed.

The meeting adjourned.
