MINUTES FOR JANUARY 9, 2019, 3:00 P.M.

Pursuant to the call of the Chairman, the Senate Committee on the Judiciary met on January 9, 2018, at 3:00 p.m. in Room 208-W.

All members being present, with the exception of Senators Takubo and Ojeda, who were absent, the Chairman declared the presence of a quorum. (See attached roll call and agenda).

Chairman Trump introduced the 2019 Senate Committee on the Judiciary staff to the committee members.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee adopted the Rules of the Senate to govern the committee in its deliberations.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee authorized Chairman Trump to set an agenda of items to be considered by the committee.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee authorized staff to, as needed, make any technical corrections to the bills, resolutions and drafts which may be brought before the committee.

Senator Weld moved to adjourn.

Unanimous consent being granted, Senator Weld withdrew his motion.

On motion of Senator Romano, the committee adopted a requirement that witnesses appearing before the committee be administered the oath, with the exception of elected officials and Senate staff.

Chairman Trump welcomed new members of the committee.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee adjourned.
