On motion of Senator Weld, the committee reported the committee substitute to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.


S. B. 102 - Relating generally to powers and authority of courthouse security officers.

Tom Smith, Chief Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.


On motion of Senator Weld, the committee agreed to the committee substitute.
