MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 13, 2019, 3:00 P.M.

Pursuant to the call of the Chairman, the Senate Committee on the Judiciary met on February 13, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. in Room 208-W.

All members being present, with the exception of Senators Lindsay, Romano and Takubo, who were absent, the Chairman declared the presence of a quorum. (See attached roll call and agenda).

On motion of Senator Weld, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Chairman Trump removed **H. B. 2474** from the agenda.

**S. B. 512 - Regulating pawnbrokers.**

Debra Graham, Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.

With leave of the committee, Adam Crawford, Kanawha County Sheriff, West Virginia Fraternal Order of Police, was administered the oath prescribed by Senate Rule 28a by Chairman Trump, addressed the committee, and responded to questions. (See attached oath.)

Senators Weld and Jeffries moved to amend the committee substitute by striking page 4, lines 32-38, Section 2, subsection (e).

Senator Boso moved to amend the committee substitute on page 4, line 36, Section 2, subsection (e) to change 60 day archive to 30 day archive.

Chairman Trump ruled the motion to amend takes precedence over the motion to strike.

The committee adopted amendment offered by Senator Boso.

Senator Jeffries moved to amend the committee substitute on page 4, line 38, Section 2, subsection (e) to add an effective date of January 1, 2021.

Chairman Trump ruled the motion to amend takes precedence over the motion to strike.


The committee adopted the amendment offered by Senator Jeffries.

Senators Jeffries and Weld withdrew their amendment to strike Section 2, subsection (e).


On motion of Senator Weld, the committee agreed to the committee substitute, as amended.
