Chairman Maynard called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. A silent roll call was taken by staff and a quorum was present.

Senator Mann approved the minutes of the January 21, 2019 meeting.

Chairman Maynard brought the following bills before the committee.

S. B. 331 - Using leashed dogs to track mortally wounded deer or bear.

Counsel explained the bill.

Questions and answers followed.

On motion of Senator Mann the committee recommended SB331 be reported to the full senate with the recommendation that it do pass.

S. B. 332 - Relating to Class Q special hunting permit for disabled persons.

Counsel explained the bill.

Questions and answers followed.

On motion of Senator Mann the committee recommended SB332 be reported to the full senate with the recommendation that it do pass.

S. B. 389 - Allowing developmentally disabled person purchase base hunting license.

Counsel explained the bill.

Questions and answers followed.

On motion of Senator Stollings the committee amended the bill. (see attached amendment below)

With leave of the committee, Stephen McDaniel, DNR, administered the oath prescribed by Senate Rule 28a by Chairman Maynard, addressed the committee and responded to questions.

The question being on the amendment from Senator Stollings, the same was put and the amendment was adopted.

On motion of Senator Sypolt the committee amended the bill. (see attached amendment below)

The question being on the amendment from Senator Sypolt, the same was put and the amendment was adopted.

Without objection, the committee authorized counsel to incorporate the bill and the amendments into a committee substitute.

On motion of Senator Mann, the committee agreed to the language of the committee substitute.

On motion of Senator Mann, the committee recommended the Com Sub for SB389 be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.

Senator Mann, moved to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously.

Amendments made in committee by Stollings and Sypolt

The amendment was not put in the Committee Substitute so Stollings and Maynard did a floor amendment.

The committee moved to provide liability immunity for the physicians who certify a developmental disability. And, the committee moved to require the DNR to draft rules for a temporary certification for developmental disorders that are progressive in nature.
