**Minutes for JANUARY 21, 2020, 2:00 PM**

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Education met on January 21, 2020, 2:00 PM in Room M-451.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Boley, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The first item on the agenda was a Committee Substitute for SB 303, Enacting Students' Right to Know Act. Hank Hager, Counsel, explained the Committee Substitutes in lieu of having it read.
