Minutes for FEBRUARY 04, 2020, 1:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources met on February 04, 2020, 1:00 PM in Room 451-M.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Tarr, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented Senate Bill 575 along with a Committee Substitute designating local fire department as safe-surrender site to accept physical custody of certain children from lawful custodian. Counsel responded to questions from the committee. Senator Tarr moved to agree to the language of the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 575. The Chairman put the question on the motion and the motion was adopted. Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Tarr who moved that the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 575 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The Chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was adopted.

Chairman Maroney advised the committee that House Bill 4419 would not be presented today but will be presented at a later date.


Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources, who presented House Bill 4058 relating to pharmacy benefit manager. Ms. Dellinger suggested a Strike and Insert Amendment for HB4058. Senator Tarr moved to amend HB4058 with the Strike and Insert Amendment explained by counsel. The Chairman put the question on the motion and the motion was adopted. Chairman Maroney recognized Senator Tarr who moved that the House Bill 4058, as amended, be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The Chairman put the question on the motion. The motion was adopted.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the Chairman recognized Senator Tarr.
