Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Judiciary met on January 09, 2020, 10:00 AM in Room 208-W.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

Chairman Trump welcomed the new member of the committee.

Chairman Trump introduced the 2020 Senate Committee on the Judiciary staff to the committee members.

S. B. 94 - Providing persons with physical disabilities ability to vote by electronic absentee ballot.

Sarah Canterbury, Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.
