### Minutes for JANUARY 24, 2020, 2:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on the Judiciary met on January 24, 2020, 2:00 PM in Room 208-W.

Members absent: Senators Takubo, Baldwin, Hardesty, Romano

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Weld, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

**S. B. 208 - Protecting consumers from unfair pricing practices during state of emergency.**

Chris Alder, Counsel, explained the bill and responded to questions.

With leave of the committee, Frank Hartman, Marathon Petroleum, was administered the oath prescribed by Senate Rule 28a by Chairman Trump, addressed the committee, and responded to questions. (See attached oath.)

Chairman Trump referred **S. B. 208** to a subcommittee consisting of Senators Cline, Jeffries and Clements.

**S. B. 339 - DHHR rule relating to public water systems.**

Debra Graham, Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee agreed to the committee substitute.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee reported the committee substitute to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.

**S. B. 275 - Creating Intermediate Court of Appeals.**

Sarah Canterbury, Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.

On Motion of Senator Weld the committee adjourned.
