On motion of Senator Deeds, the Com. Sub for S.B. 427 was reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.

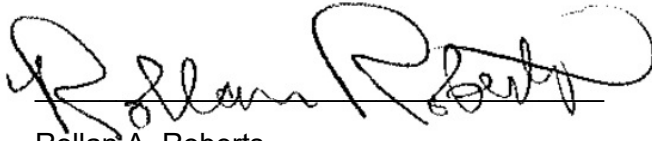
Com. Sub. S. B. 534 - Relating to requirements to administer polygraphs.

The committee agreed to the language of the committee substitute.

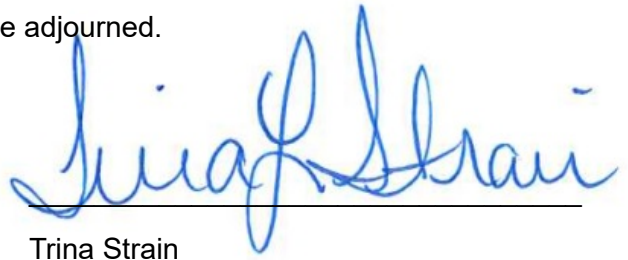
On motion of Senator Deeds, the Com. Sub for S.B. 534 was reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.
