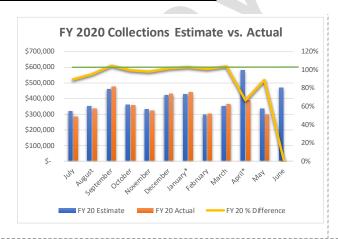

#### **General Revenue**

General Revenue collections for May totaled \$296,789,445, **falling below** the monthly estimate of \$334,443,000 by \$37,653,555. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$3,988,629,610.

As of the end of May the state has collected 84.98% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,693,640,000. At this time, the state should have collected 89.85% of its yearly revenue.

#### **Personal Income Tax**

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$125,890,526. This figure is \$11,109,474 **below** the May estimate of \$137,000,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$1,767,559,489.

As of the end of May the state has collected 82% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,154,880,000. At this time the state should have collected 90% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

#### **Consumer Sales and Service Tax**

Collections of the Consumer Sales and Service Tax (CS&S) for the month of May were \$108,689,010 and were \$9,110,990 **below** the monthly estimate of \$117,800,000. Total Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$1,225,483,2844.

As of the month of May the state has collected 88.15% of its yearly estimated collections. At this time the state should have collected 89.16% of its yearly estimate. This current trend puts the state **not on** track for meeting the yearly CS&S tax collection estimate.

# **Severance Tax**

Severance tax collections for May were \$15,717,184. This figure is \$16,782,816 **below** the monthly estimate of \$32,500,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$248,152,123.

As of the end of May the state has collected 69% of its total yearly collections of \$376,800,000. At this time the state should have collected 90% of its yearly severance tax collections. 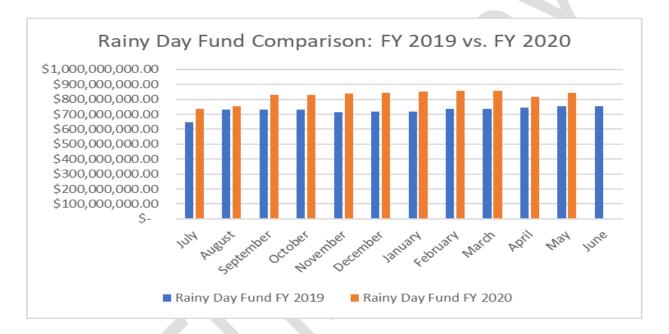
