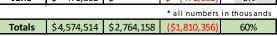

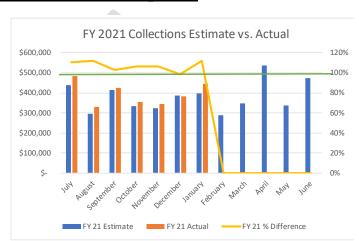

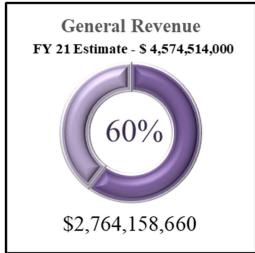
General Revenue

General Revenue collections for January totaled \$444,677,746, exceeding the monthly estimate of \$398,054,000 by \$46,623,746. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$2,764,158,660.

As of the end of January the state has collected 60% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,574,514,000. At this time, the state should have collected 57% of its yearly revenue. This current trend puts the state on track for meeting yearly revenue estimates.

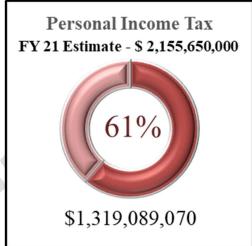
Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$235,664,367. This figure is \$26,564,367 **above** the January estimate of \$209,100,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$1,319,089,070.

Fiscal Year 2021 PIT YTD Performance Exceeding estimates by \$61,389,070



As of the end of January the state has collected 61% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,155,650,000. At this time the state should have collected 58% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state on track for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

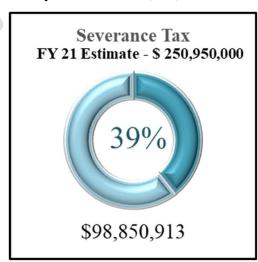
Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for January were \$29,008,346. This figure is \$8,208,346 above the monthly estimate of \$20,800,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$98,850,913.

As of the end of January the state has collected 39% of its total yearly collections of \$250,950,000. At this time the state should have collected 39%* of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state on track for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

*Severance Tax estimated collections for the first 6 months of the yearly were \$78,000,000, and for the last six months of the year are estimated at \$172,950,000.

Other Notable Collections

Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for the month were \$220,960 **above** the January estimate of \$131,300,000 at \$131,520,960.

Tobacco Products Tax collections for January were \$11,119,550. These collections were **below** the monthly estimate of \$11,900,000 by \$780,450.

Lottery

Total gross lottery collections for December were \$87,501,000. This figure is \$8,284,000 **above** the monthly estimate of \$79,454,000. Total gross lottery collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$538,616,000.

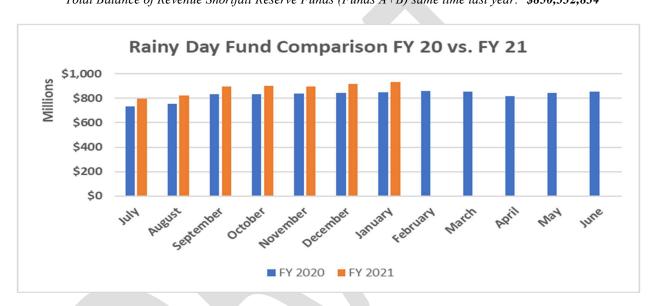
