Motion was made to summarily suspend the license of Roland Chalifoux, D.O. **(Whitler/Blatt)**

NEW BUSINESS:

Executive Director Report:

- Licensure Analyst:** The Board previously approved a temporary, full time position for a licensure analyst to assist the Board during high volume license renewal period. The Executive Director requested that position be made full time, permanent. Motion was made to make the temporary position, permanent. **(Whitler/Schreiber)**
- Expert Witness Invoice:** The Board received an invoice from Jason Pope, M.D. for \$22,575 in conjunction with his time spent on the Phillip Fisher, D.O. hearing. As this is an excessive amount, the Board requested a full accounting, day by day and month by month of the time spent on the case at \$300 per hour. Future contracts will reflect a cap on any given case.
- FSMB Board Attorney Workshop & CMBI:** The Annual Board Attorney Workshop is being held in Savannah, Georgia on October 23 – 24, 2014. Approval was given for Ms. Akers to attend. The CMBI workshop is scheduled for November in Baltimore, Maryland. Mr. Kidd has already re-certified.
- Pharmacy Rules:** A copy of the proposed joint revisions to the pharmacist immunization rules in Title 15, Series 12, to allow pharmacy interns to give meningococcal vaccines with a Pharmacist present, was presented to the Board prior to going to the Legislative Rule Making Committee. No changes were recommended.
- Office Lease:** The current five-year lease with Neyer Management for the office space for the Board is up for renewal in November 2014. A new lease agreement has been presented to the Board for approval. The only increase is the \$55.00, per month, added for a fourth parking space. Motion was made to approve the new five year lease and submit to the West Virginia State Real Estate Division for approval and processing. **(Schreiber/Whitler)**
- Uniform Application:** The Federation of State Medical Boards has assured the Board that grant money is available for the implementation of the Uniform Application with the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine. The Executive Director was advised to follow up with Big Picture for a projected cost and then apply to FSMB for a grant. **(Whitler/Muscari)**
- Complaint Filed Against Board Counsel:** A complaint has been filed with the Office of Disciplinary Counsel by a former witness in the Phillip Fisher, D.O. hearings. The complaint is against the Board's counsel, Ms. Akers. If Attorney General's Office does not provide legal counsel for their employees and Ms. Akers was acting as a representative of the Board, this should be reported to BRIM, our insurance carrier. Motion made to contact BRIM about possible legal representation for Ms. Akers, as may be needed. **(Whitler/Schreiber)**
- Licensing Issues:**
MedExpress MedExpress submitted requests for additional work sites for four osteopathic physicians. All have current licenses and have renewed their CSL's.
- Robert Sutherland, D.O.** Additional information was obtained following Dr. Sutherland's interview with the full Board at our June 26th meeting. His application still reflects a "No" answer to question #1. Upon correction and written explanation to question #1, Dr. Sutherland will be issued a license. **(Muscari/Schreiber)**

Brian McDevitt, D.O. Current Consent Order for reinstatement requires the completion of a CPEP assessment or a comparable assessment. Dr. McDevitt has concerns over the osteopathic representation within the multiple choice section of the evaluation. CPEP has confirmed that NBME designed and scored the multiple choice portion of the assessment. Motion was made to allow Dr. McDevitt to sit for the Convex exam in place of CPEP. However, results of the CPEP assessment must be released to the Board before approval of license reinstatement. **(Whitler/Muscari)**

Phillip Fisher, D.O.: A hearing was held in the 4th Floor Conference Room at 405 Capitol Street from the last week in July through first week of August. We are awaiting the completed transcripts for each counsel to submit their Findings of Fact and Conclusions to the Administrative Law Judge.

The Board moved into Executive Session at 4:35 PM with the Executive Director and Board Counsel present. **(Schreiber/Whitler)**

Motion was made to move back into Public Session at 5:10 PM. **(Whitler/Schreiber)**

Only two claims have been filed in circuit court and they require a response from counsel by September 22, 2014. Mr. Oxley discussed options open to the Board regarding defense strategies and a possible cross claim against HOPE Clinic. Motion was made to authorize counsel to file an appropriate cross claim. **(Whitler/Schreiber)**

Duangnapa S. Cuddy, D.O.: The amended application of Dr. Cuddy was approved for a full, unrestricted license. **(Muscari/Schreiber)**


Joel Smithers, D.O.: License application approved with Consent Order to mirror that of the North Carolina Board of Medicine. **(Schreiber/Muscari)**

Update on Board Civil Suits: The Board has received 13 notices for claims to be filed with two having already been officially filed. Amendments are being received with cross claim filings and are being forwarded to Perry Oxley at Anspach Law Office. It is believed that depositions will begin after first of the year. Statute of Limitations would have ended in October.

2015 PA Renewals: Physician Assistant license renewals will begin February 1, 2015. This will be the first renewal cycle that the licensee's will need to complete a Practice Agreement. Emergency Rule CSR 24-2 provided for continuation of their Privilege Request List until the next renewal cycle.

NEW BUSINESS:

Executive Director Report:

Nomination for CSMP Advisory Committee: The West Virginia Controlled Substances Monitoring Program has offered the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine an opportunity to nominate someone to serve on the Advisory Committee for a recently vacated position. The WV Osteopathic Medical Association nominated C. Clark Milton, D.O. to fill the position. The WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine concurred with the nomination of Dr. Milton. **(Rubin/Muscari)**

Purchasing Audit: The West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine was included in a random Purchasing Inspection in September 2014. The last inspection on the Board's purchasing process was completed in 2007. The review period was July 2013 through June 2014, with 138 procurement transactions for a total of \$89,539.72 included. All findings were addressed by the Board with appropriate documentation, but no changes were made to the report.

Telemedicine Policy: The Board reviewed the FSMB Model Policy on Telemedicine and the policy being proposed by the West Virginia Board of Medicine. Motion was made to accept the wording in the policy being proposed by the WV Board of Medicine with the addition of the Definition found in the FSMB Model Policy:

Telemedicine is not an audio-only, telephone conversation, email/instant messaging conversation, or fax.

With the inclusion of the above added definition, the Board approved the Telemedicine Policy drafted by the WV Board of Medicine. **(Whitler/Muscari)** Dr. Schreiber abstained from voting.

Interstate Licensure Compact: After hearing Jonathan Jagoda's presentation, there was much discussion about the interstate compact. Concerns were raised regarding the standards for a compact license being higher than that for licensing with either the West Virginia Board of Medicine or the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine. Also, no mention of Complex versus USMLE. Motion was made to support the presentation of the Interstate Compact License to the West Virginia Legislature in 2015. **(Blatt/Whitler)** Motion was withdrawn for lack of consensus.

PA Formulary Request: A request to add Forteo to the PA Formulary was received from a Physician Assistant under the supervision of an Orthopedic Surgeon. The Board asked for additional documentation from the PA and his supervising physician as to the utilization of the drug, Forteo in their practice.

Licensing Issues:
MedExpress MedExpress submitted requests for additional work sites for four osteopathic physicians. Three have current licenses and have renewed their CSL's. One is a newly licensed physician who has not applied for a CSL. Executive Director Report:

Update on Interstate Compact: Nine state legislatures have now approved the Medical Interstate Compact concept, therefore, the Commission can begin its work in Establishing policies, procedures and bylaws. A national press conference has been scheduled in Washington, D.C. on June 24, 2015. Both WV licensing boards have been invited to participate. Motion made for Executive Director to attend the Press Conference as the Board's representative. **(Whitler/Schreiber)**

- WVU List Request:** Original physician listing request was received by Board Office in February. No action to date.
- Lobbyist Contract:** Current quarter will expire at end of June. Board elected not to renew the contract.
- CSMP Review Committee Nominee:** A request was received from the Executive Director of the Board of Pharmacy requesting an osteopathic physician be nominated by the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine for the vacancy left by the retirement of C. Clark Milton, D.O. Because of potential conflict of interest with filing of complaints from the CSMP, the Board did not place a nomination. It should come from West Virginia Osteopathic Medical Association.
- Board Staffing:** A resignation had been received from the Administrative Assistant in May, but she asked to return to her position after being gone for only one week.
- Moral Character Requirements:** The Board discussed the necessity of requiring Moral Character References for residents after their first year of internship. The recommendation letter should be adequate if completed by the Residency Director. The Executive Director is asked to develop a form incorporating the residency recommendation and the moral character reference into one document beginning July 1, 2016.
- Policies/Procedures:** The following policies were presented for review:
- 1) Telemedicine Policy: Senate Bill 334 was presented during the 2015 session of the West Virginia Legislature. This bill outlined changes to the WV Code to include telemedicine practice, requirements, exceptions, definitions and rulemaking. However, the bill died in committee leaving the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine with no statutory reference to telemedicine. A guideline was drafted which incorporated portions of that bill and the model policy for telemedicine provided by the Federation of State Medical Boards. The guideline was tabled until all members had opportunity to review the material.
 - 2) Purchasing Card Policy/Procedures: A revised P-Card Policy was presented for review. With the addition of travel expenses being added to the Board's Purchase Card, the policy needed to have the travel provisions added to it. The policy was signed by the Chief Financial Officer.
 - 3) Confidentiality Policy: The Confidentiality Policy was reviewed and all Board Members signed their Confidentiality Statements for 2015-16.
 - 4) Safety Policy: The Safety Policy was presented for the annual review. All departmental safety checks have been conducted and will be reported through the BRIM Loss Control Survey for 2015.
- Licensing Issues:** Six (6) dispensing requests were received for Osteopathic Physicians. All have current Controlled Substance Licenses and all dispensing sites were approved. The Board requested written explanation from MedExpress as to how the recent buyout by Optum will affect dispensing contracts.
- MedExpress:**
- Collaborative Pharmacy Practice Agreements:** Since the pilot programs in 2008, the Board has not received an application for a Collaborative Pharmacy Practice Agreement and an application had not been developed for such a license. However, in 2015 a request has been received by the Board from a Pharmacist to enter into a Collaborative Pharmacy Practice Agreement with Charleston Internal Medicine Group which has several Osteopathic Physicians working in the practice. An application form should be developed and provided to the first applicant according to 11 CSR 8.

Physician Assistants Without DEA's: If a physician assistant applicant does not provide a DEA, the PA is not given prescriptive privileges. A DEA is currently required by Legislative Rule for prescriptive privileges, regardless of whether the PA will be prescribing any controlled substances.

- 1) **Interstate Medical Licensing Compact:** The first meeting of the Interstate Medical Licensing Compact is scheduled for October 27 and 28, 2015 in Chicago, Illinois. The Governor's Office has delineated the responsibility of appointing the Commissioners representing West Virginia on the Commission to the two State Licensing Board. Motion was made and unanimously passed to appoint Diana Shepard, Executive Director, as the Commissioner to represent the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine on the IMLC Commission. **(Rubin/Whitler)**
- 2) **FSMB Attorney Workshop:** The 2015 Attorney Workshop, sponsored by the Federation of State Medical Boards will be held in Las Vegas, Nevada on November 12-13, 2015. Motion was made and unanimously passed to provide travel and hotel funds to Board Counsel, Jennifer Akers, to attend. **(Rubin/Rowe)**
- 3) **Tri-Regulator Symposium:** Dr. Rubin, Secretary of the Board, was planning to attend the Tri-Regulator Symposium in Arlington, Virginia. However, his schedule was changed cancelling his trip to Arlington.
- 4) **Supreme Court Case No. 15-0131:** The West Virginia Board of Nursing had its second case presented to the West Virginia Supreme Court earlier this month. This issue dealt, primarily, with the Board's non-compliance with *W.Va. Code 30-1-5(c)* which requires a certified letter be sent to the complainant within six months of the complaint filing to provide an update on the status of the complaint. The Court's decision for the RN Board case has not yet been given. However, with Complaint 2013-16, the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine may be facing the same issue. While regular communication was exchanged with the complainant via telephone and letters, a certified letter at six months was not sent while attempts at setting a hearing were unsuccessful with the physician and his counsel. Legal Counsel and the Executive Director have worked on procedural and computer changes to provide six month alerts on all complaint cases.
- 5) **PA Formulary Review:** The current formulary was presented for review. Most state medical licensing boards have eliminated the use of a drug formulary as it quickly becomes outdated with new drugs and schedule changes. Motion was made to eliminate the current drug formulary and replace it by stipulating what class of drugs and dosages can be prescribed by Physician Assistants within their application for licensure and their Practice Agreements. **(Jones/Rubin)**
- 6) **WVU Request Regarding DEA Requirement for Physician Assistants:** A request for interpretation of *24 CSR 02.11.7* was received from WVU. If a Physician Assistant is not going to prescribe Schedule III through V controlled substances, must they obtain a DEA? Historically, the Board has required a DEA not knowing whether the PA would be prescribing controlled substances. Re-interpretation of *24 CSR 02.11.7* was made for the requirement of a DEA to be determined by the application process and asking whether or not the supervising physician wants the PA to prescribe controlled substances. **(Jones/Rubin)**
- 7) **3 Hour CME Requirement Within First Year of Licensing:** SB437 required all newly licensed healthcare practitioners to complete the 3 hour Pain Prescribing CME requirement within the first year of licensing. An audit was conducted revealing 29 Physician Assistants and 12 Osteopathic Physicians who had not done so within the first year. A letter was mailed to all non-compliance licensees and, as of this meeting all have met those requirements.

Motion was made at 12:00 PM to recess for lunch. **(Adams/Muscari)**

President Miller re-convened the meeting at 1:35 PM.

- 8) Request for Use of Vyvanse in Treating Binge Eating Disorder: The Board was approached by Shire Pharmaceutical Company after the deadline for filing legislative rule changes for the 2016 Legislative Session. Shire was requesting a change to **24 CSR 01-18.1.dd** to allow the use of Vyvanse in the treatment of Binge Eating Disorder. This issue will be tabled until the November meeting to allow further study and review. In the meantime, the Board goes on record to not discipline any physician who uses Vyvanse, as directed, and with clear documentation of patient progress without complications.
- 9) Telemedicine Guidelines: A proposed set of guidelines for the practice of osteopathic telemedicine was tabled from the last meeting. It is presented for approval as an internal policy for the practice of osteopathic telemedicine until we can get the telemedicine bill, which was killed in committee this year, re-submitted for 2016. Motion to approve was made and unanimously passed. **(Rubin/Whitler)**
- 10) Board Office Phone System: The Executive Director requested permission to begin looking at new phone systems for the Board Office. The Board requested quotes be presented at the next meeting for a phone system with conferencing and intercom capabilities for all four staff members in the office.
- 11) Security for Board Office: The Executive Director reported a couple of instances within the last six months in which building security was placed on standby when particular visitors were expected in the Board Office. Staff has no rear exit within the office should they be threatened in any way. Request for study and review of ways to provide more security within the Board Office. The Board granted permission to investigate adequate security measures.

Licensing Issues:
MedExpress

MedExpress presented several new dispensing sites for multiple osteopathic licensees for Board approval. The Executive Director questioned why this procedure is required. It was determined that when controlled substances were being dispensed from those facilities the Board needed to be aware of those sites. Now that controlled substances can no longer be dispensed without a prescription, this has become a moot issue and no longer needs to be reported to the Board.

First Licensed Collaborative Pharmacy Practice:

Eight years after the first pilot programs for collaborative pharmacy practices, the Board has licensed its first collaborative. The license will be for a two year period and then will the pharmacist will apply for renewal.

Onsite Physician Assistant Inspections:

Four unannounced inspections were conducted by one of the Board's contract investigators on four Physician Assistants whose licenses were up for renewal in 2015. Included in that review were two PA's under the supervision of David Tolliver, D.O., one with Claudia Duncan, D.O. and one with John Short, D.O. All appeared to be practicing within their scope of practice with the exception on one Physician Assistant who has a current open complaint and will be discussed in Executive Session.

The Board moved into Executive Session at 2:35 PM with the Executive Director, Board Counsel and Licensure analyst present. **(Rubin/Whitler)**

Motion was made to move back into Public Session at 3:35 PM. **(Muscarel/Whitler)**

Richard Blackburn, D.O.:

A hearing was scheduled for tomorrow, June 9, 2016, after several continuances requested by respondent's counsel. On June 3, 2016, Board Office received a letter from Dr. Blackburn's counsel offering to surrender his license.

Motion was made and unanimously passed to accept the surrender of license and cancel the hearing. **(Adams/Rowe)**

Michael Kostenko, D.O.:
(Complaint 2015-10)

Board received and reviewed Hearing Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations from hearing held on March 18 and 23, 2016.

The following amendments were made to the Hearing Examiner's report:

- 1) Page 4, "Issue" should state the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine may suspend a license, limit or restrict a license or revoke any license issued by the Board, upon satisfactory proof that the licensee has demonstrated a lack of professional competence to practice osteopathic medicine with a reasonable degree of skill and safety for patients. **(§24-1-18.1.i)**

- 2) Agree with the Hearing Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law. The revocation is justified because Dr. Kostenko deviated from the accepted standards of practice and demonstrated a lack of care, skill and proper treatment contributing to the deaths of the three patients named in the complaint. As he accepted no responsibility nor demonstrated any concern for changing his way of practicing pain management, the Board has reason to believe this practice will continue unless definitive action is taken by the Board.

Motion was made to accept the recommendations of the Hearing Examiner, as amended, and permanently revoke the license of Michael Kostenko, D.O.. **(Rowe/Jones)** Motion carried with Jimmy Adams, D.O. abstaining from the vote as an expert witness.

This is the West Virginia Osteopathic Licensees' lifeline to licensing questions and answers. Like everywhere else in medicine today, lots of changes have occurred regarding licensing for physicians and physician assistants. We urge you to visit our website, www.wvbdosteo.org and click on "Legislation" to review all current rules regulating your medical license in 2015.

The biggest change in 2014/15 is in relation to Physician Assistant licensing. As of June 6, 2014, a PA can apply for a license without having a working contract with a supervising physician. **However, the PA cannot begin working until a Practice Agreement has been completed and signed by both the PA and the Physician; and signed as approved by the Board. The Practice Agreement now outlines what the PA can do under the supervision of what physician(s), including prescriptive authority. All Physician Assistants should complete a Practice Agreement even if your license is not scheduled for renewal in 2015.**

**WV BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC
PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT LICENSES
DUE TO EXPIRE MARCH 31, 2015**

If you received a postcard with this newsletter, that means your license is up for renewal before March 31, 2015. No paper applications will be mailed. License renewals will be done online. Just follow the following steps for renewal:

- 1) From www.wvbdosteo.org click on “PA Renewals” in left hand column;
- 2) Log in with either your last name, license number or last 4 digits of SSN;
- 3) Enter “Submit and Continue.”
- 4) Continue to review all fields of information and correct those fields needing to be changed/updated. After each page, you can select “Save for Later” and it will save your application and allow you to come back to it. If you are finished with the application, press “Submit and Continue;”
- 5) When answering the personal information questions, if you have a “yes” answer it will bring up a screen for you to type in your response;
- 6) Answer the State mandated child support questions;
- 7) The CME report allows you to link directly with the NCCPA to request your CME hours. If you submit a copy of your NCCPA CME certificate, we will keep them on file and you will never be contacted during a CME audit. Remember, if you also have prescriptive authority, you must document at least 10 hours of CME in Pharmacology topics within the 100 required hours.
- 8) Lastly you check a certification box which attests to the accuracy of your information.
- 9) The next screen is the payment screen for you to enter your credit card information. You will be given the opportunity to print your receipt at the conclusion of the form.
- 10) If you choose not to pay by credit card, you can mail a check for the \$100 license renewal fee and, if submitting a Practice Agreement, the \$100 fee for it all at the same time.
- 11) The items that are required before your application will be considered complete:
 - a) Complete Listing of CME’s
 - b) Performance Evaluation signed by both PA and Physician
 - c) Current Copy of DEA (if have prescriptive authority)
 - d) Answers to any “Yes” questions
 - e) Proof of Board Approved CME on Pain Prescribing
 - f) Application Fee

**DRUGS PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS ARE
PROHIBITED FROM PRESCRIBING**

As of the printing of this newsletter the following classifications of drugs are not allowed to be prescribed by a Physician Assistant.

- 1) Schedules I and II;
- 2) Greater than a 72 hour supply of any drug listed under Schedule III;
- 3) Antineoplastics and Chemotherapeutic agents;
- 4) Radio-pharmaceuticals, general anesthetics and radiographic contrast materials.

There is a bill being considered to allow Hydrocodone combination drugs be prescribed for a 72 hour supply. **PLEASE CHECK WITH BOARD OFFICE FOLLOWING THE 2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION TO SEE IF THIS BILL WAS PASSED.** Legislative Rules will need to be written by the Board to make the bill enforceable.

LICENSING OF PAIN CLINICS

The required licensing of Pain Management Clinics began July 1, 2014. Because this law has been in effect since 2012, there is no additional grace period for applying for licensure. If your practice meets the definition of a Pain Clinic, you **MUST** apply with OHFLAC through WV Department of Human and Health Services for a license to continue their current practice of medicine in the State. The contact person at OHFLAC is Sylvia Fields, Program Manager (304) 558-0050.

If you meet the requirements but do not apply for a license, OHFLAC will report that to the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine and the Board will open a complaint. If you are unsure whether you meet the requirements, contact the Board Office or OHFLAC.

Pain Clinic Definition:

Privately owned clinic, facility or office wherein the total number of chronic pain patients treated during any 1 month who receive tramadol, opioids, carisoprodol, or other Schedule II or III controlled substances equals greater than 50%.

Included in SB 437 passed by the 2012 Legislature and signed by the Governor was the development of a Review Committee who receives reports from the State Medical Examiner regarding overdose deaths. This committee of healthcare professionals, including an osteopathic physician, will make determinations on a case-by-case basis of unusual prescribing practices and report their findings to the practitioner's licensing board and to law enforcement.

PHYSICIAN LICENSE RENEWALS TO BEGIN MAY 1, 2015

If you received a postcard with this newsletter, that means your license is up for renewal before June 30, 2015. By this time, every licensee should have used our online application service and should be aware that no paper application will be mailed. The postcard is your only notice. Beginning May 1, 2015, you can go online and complete your renewal application. Things to remember while completing your application:

- 1) Check all pre-populated fields to make sure the information is correct. Once you electronically sign the application, you are attesting to ALL the information contained therein;
- 2) Have your current DEA certificate online and ready to upload with your application. This alleviates you having to fax it to the Board Office;
- 3) When you complete your license renewal application, don't forget to complete your CSL (Controlled Substance License) at the same time. The system will remind you, so follow its instructions;
- 4) Have at least 32 hours of CME ready to be entered into your application OR upload your AOA CME report for the July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015 licensing period. Be sure to include your 3 hours of BOARD-APPROVED CME on Best Practice Prescribing and Drug Diversion. The only way to be sure the program has been approved by the Board is to go to our website and look under "Upcoming Events." If it is listed there – It has been approved.

WEST VIRGINIA BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE ADOPTS NEW TELEMEDICINE GUIDELINES

DEFINITION OF TELEMEDICINE

“Telemedicine” means the practice of osteopathic medicine using electronic communications, information technology or other means of interaction between a licensed healthcare practitioner in one location, and a patient in another location, with or without an intervening healthcare provider. The utilization of electronic communications in on call, cross coverage and emergency services situations, is not “telemedicine.” Generally, telemedicine is not an audio-only telephone conversation, email/instant messaging conversation, or fax.

“Telemedicine technologies” mean technologies and devices enabling secure electronic communications and information exchange in the practice of telemedicine and generally involve the application of secure, real time video conferencing or similar secure video services, remote monitoring, interactive audio and store and forward digital image or health data technology to provide or support health care delivery by replicating the interaction of a traditional in person encounter between a provider and a patient.

THE PRACTICE OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE THROUGH TELEMEDICINE:

The practice of osteopathic medicine occurs where the patient is located at the time telemedicine technologies are used. An osteopathic physician or physician assistant who engages in the practice of osteopathic medicine through telemedicine technologies with respect to patients located in this state shall be licensed by the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine, until such time as the Interstate Medical Licensing Compact has been approved and is operating under the authority of the Interstate Medical Licensing Commission.

An osteopathic physician or physician assistant using telemedicine technologies to practice osteopathic medicine for a patient shall:

- 1) Verify the identity and location of the patient;
- 2) Provide the patient with confirmation of the identity, location and qualifications of the Osteopathic physician or physician assistant;
- 3) Establish and/or maintain an osteopathic physician or physician assistant patient Relationship which conforms to the standard of care;
- 4) Determine whether telemedicine technologies are appropriate for the particular patient Presentation for which the practice of osteopathic medicine is to be rendered;
- 5) Obtain from the patient informed consent for the use of telemedicine technologies in the Practice of osteopathic medicine for the patient;
- 6) Conduct all appropriate evaluations and history of the patient consistent with traditional standards of care for the particular patient presentation;
- 7) Verify compliance with the requirements of medical record documentation.

Items 2 through 5 in the above section do not apply to the practice of pathology and radiology medicine through store and forward telemedicine.

Where an existing osteopathic physician or physician assistant/patient relationship is not present prior to the utilization to telemedicine technologies, or when services are rendered solely through telemedicine technologies, an osteopathic physician or physician assistant/ patient relationship may only be established through the use of telemedicine technologies which incorporate interactive audio using store and forward technology with real time videoconferencing or similar secure video services during the initial osteopathic physician or physician assistant/ patient encounter. However, an osteopathic physician/patient relationship may be established through store and forward telemedicine for the practice of pathology and radiology.

Once an osteopathic physician or physician assistant/patient relationship has been established, the osteopathic physician or physician assistant, with the informed consent of the patient, may utilize any telemedicine technology which meets the standard of care and is appropriate for the particular patient presentation.

The utilization of telemedicine technologies to practice osteopathic medicine on a patient for whom the standard of care requires an in-person, physical examination or osteopathic manipulation therapy shall constitute dishonorable, unethical and unprofessional conduct.

PRESCRIBING THROUGH TELEMEDICINE TECHNOLOGIES:

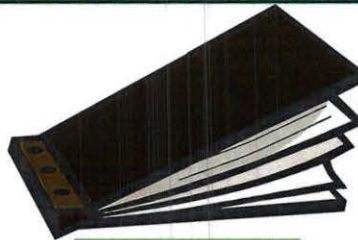
The practice of osteopathic medicine provided via telemedicine technologies, including the establishment of an osteopathic physician or physician assistant/patient relationship and issuing a prescription via electronic means as part of a telemedicine encounter, are subject to the same standard of care, professional practice requirements and scope of practice limitations as traditional in-person osteopathic physician or physician assistant/patient encounters. Treatment, including issuing a prescription, based solely on an online questionnaire does not constitute an acceptable standard of care.

An osteopathic physician or physician assistant who has an osteopathic physician or physician assistant/patient relationship and who practices osteopathic medicine to a patient solely through the utilization of telemedicine technologies may not prescribe any controlled substances listed in Schedule I or II of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

MEDICAL RECORD DOCUMENTATION FOR PATIENT ENCOUNTERS VIA TELEMEDICINE:

The patient record established during the use of telemedicine technologies shall be accessible and documented for both the osteopathic physician, physician assistant and the patient, consistent with the laws and legislative rules governing patient health care records and shall include a copy of the informed consent to the practice of osteopathic medicine via telemedicine technologies. All laws governing the confidentiality of health care information and governing patient access to medical records shall apply to records of the practice of osteopathic medicine provided through telemedicine technologies. An osteopathic physician or physician assistant solely providing services using telemedicine technologies shall make documentation of the encounter easily available to the patient and, subject to the patient's consent, any identified care provider of the patient immediately after the encounter.

CME AUDITS TO BE DONE



IN DECEMBER

Chapter 30 Licensing Boards are required to conduct a CME audit each calendar year following the renewal of an osteopathic physician's license. If you renewed your WV license in 2015 and did not submit CME certificates with your application, you may receive a letter requesting proof of completion of the CME's reported in your application. A random 10% of the license renewals will be audited. If you receive a CME audit letter, please respond to the Board as quickly as possible.

When reporting CME's on your applications, do not just enter a range of dates, i.e., June 2012 – June 2015. Each CME program needs to be entered with the correct number of approved hours documented. Also, remember the CME schedule for AOA membership is 3 years. WV License cycle is two years.

The 2015 Appalachian Addiction & Prescription Drug Abuse Conference

The annual Appalachian Addiction & Prescription Drug Abuse Conference was held in Charleston, West Virginia September 24-26, 2015. This conference was the 4th conference of its type held since inception of the licensure board's three hour CME Best Practices Prescribing of Controlling Substances required education. Specifically, The Treatment of Pain and Addiction Utilizing Education and Proper Prescribing: The New Paradigm Continued.

Support for the meeting was provided by the West Virginia State Medical Association, the West Virginia Medical Professionals Health Program (WVMPHP), the West Virginia Society of Addiction Medicine, the West Virginia Board of Medicine, the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine, the West Virginia Osteopathic Medical Association, and the WVDHHR Bureau for Behavioral Health & Health Facilities. The WVMPHP in collaboration with the WVSMA and the WV Department of Health and Human Resources (supported by SAMSHA grant funds administered through the Bureau for Behavioral Health and Health Facilities) were able to continue our mutual goal of physician and other licensed healthcare professional education. CME joint sponsorship was provided by CAMC Health Education & Research Institute. Attendees earned 14.2 CME credits, inclusive of the three hour board mandatory CME; CME was available for 10 different disciplines. This included CME from the American Board of Addiction Medicine (ABAM) Maintenance of Certification. Total conference attendance (more than double 2014) of 285 included physicians, resident physicians, physician assistants, podiatrists, attorneys, nurses, dentists, psychologists, counselors/social workers, epidemiologists, nutritionists, pharmacists and both pharmacy and medical students. There were many others at various levels of training in their healthcare field. P. Bradley Hall, M.D., Conference Chair and Executive Medical Director of the WVMPHP was a featured speaker and the primary planner and organizer of this conference.

Speakers included *US Senator Joe Manchin, III, US Senator, Evan Jenkins, US Veterans Administration Secretary, Robert McDonald, Victoria Jones, Commissioner, BBHFF, Karen Bowling, MSN, Cabinet Secretary of the WVDHHR, Lynn Hankes, M.D., Alexander Wally, M.D., Glenn Treisman, M.D., PhD, Hendree Jones, PhD, Mel Pohl, M.D., Gary Carr, M.D., Betsy Williams, PhD, MPH, Andrew Kolodny, M.D., Ernie Miller, D.O., James Berry, D.O., Allen Mock, M.D., Michael Goff, Edward Eskew, D.O., Jimmy Adams, D.O., and Denzil Hawkinberry, II, M.D.*

Topics covered a broad range of relevant issues related to prescription drug abuse diversion, pain, addiction and recovery all of which underpin the paradigm for the epidemic we are facing today. Some topics included the new naloxone rescue legislation and utilization, chronic pain and addiction, clinical perspectives of pain and addiction, neonatal abstinence syndrome, proper prescribing and drug diversion, updated epidemiologic statistics, a number of case studies, heroin and the addiction epidemic, WV Laws, Rules and Regulations and Controlled Substance Abuse Monitoring Program utilization and updates.

Sponsorships by a physician education grant through the WVDHHR provided additional support inclusive of 20 scholarships for early career students, residents and

appropriate others. Many were in attendance from the Comprehensive Behavioral Health Centers. Other organizations in the field were represented, including Acadia Healthcare, Aegis Sciences Corporation, Affinity eHealth, Alkermes, Assurex Health, BioDelivery Sciences, CorrLabs, LLC, First Choice Health/First Choice Services, Firstlab, Highline Health, LLC, Indivior, IntegraLabs, Las Vegas Recovery Center, Millennium Labs, Mount Regis Center, Orexo US, Inc., Pavillon, Pfizer, Inc., The American Institute of Toxicology, The Farley Center at Williamsburg Place, Timberline Knolls Residential Treatment Center, WV Medical Insurance Agency, WV Medical Professionals Health Program, WV Society of Addiction Medicine and WVDHHR/Division of Rural Health & Recruitment.

The success of the conference is an excellent example of integration, collaboration and communication among organized medicine within the state and the expertise, passion and support of many in the field including nationally recognized experts. The WVMPPH has been informed it has an opportunity for a similar grant from the WVDHHR/BBHMF to continue its efforts in the area of physician and provider education for 2016 and we hope you will join us. Remember, you MUST provide documentation of a Board-Approved 3 hour CME course on Pain Prescribing/Drug Diversion during the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2016. - 8) Lastly you check a certification box which attests to the accuracy of your information.
- 9) The next screen is the payment screen for you to enter your credit card information. You will be given the opportunity to print your receipt at the conclusion of the form.
- 10) If you currently have a Controlled Substance License (CSL), the system will ask you if you wish to renew your CSL at the same time.
- 11) If you choose not to pay by credit card, you can mail a check for the \$400 license renewal fee, but be aware that may slow down the processing of your renewal.
- 12) The items that are required before your application will be considered complete:
 - a) Listing of at least 32 hours CME's (16 AOA)
 - b) All required fields must be completed on application
 - c) Current Copy of DEA (if renewing your CSL license)
 - d) Answers to any "Yes" questions
 - e) Proof of Board Approved CME on Pain Prescribing
 - f) Application Fee

DISCUSSIONS PHYSICIANS SHOULD BE HAVING WITH THEIR PATIENTS

The National Transportation Safety Board recently analyzed toxicology tests from 6,677 pilots who died in a total of 6,597 aviation accidents between 1990 and 2012. The results demonstrate a significant increase in the use of a variety of potentially impairing drugs.

In this study, the pilot was considered to be positive for a drug if it could be qualitatively or quantitatively identified in blood or tissue; drugs identified only in urine or used as part of resuscitative efforts were excluded.

The study revealed the following:

- 1) The proportion of pilots testing positive for at least one drug increased from 10% to 40%;
- 2) More than 20% of all pilots were positive for a potentially impairing drug, and 6% of all pilots were positive for more than one potentially impairing drug;
- 3) Overall, the most common potentially impairing drug was diphenhydramine, a sedating antihistamine;
- 4) Those pilot deaths reviewed in the last five years, revealed 8% tested positive for narcotics with hydrocodone and diazepam accounting for 20% of the positive findings.

Given the general increase in drug use in the population, it is likely that there has been a similar trend in drug use among operators across modes of transportation.

These results highlight the importance of routine discussions between health care providers and their patients about the potential risks that drugs and medical conditions can create when patients are operating a vehicle in any mode of transportation.

PHYSICIAN RESPONSIBILITIES FOR SUPERVISION OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS

As physician-led healthcare teams become more prevalent in the delivery of healthcare, the relationship between a Physician Assistant and their Supervising Physician becomes critically important. Recent changes to §24-2-1, the Legislative Rule for Physician Assistants, has made the licensing process easier in today's environment of the multi-clinic setting with both MD's and DO's working with Physician Assistants.

With the Emergency Rule change to the licensing process for Physician Assistants, a PA can work with MD's and DO's under one license and can be issued a license without a named supervisor but cannot see patients until a Practice Agreement has been completed with a supervisor. With these changes there are duties and responsibilities that each Supervising Physician must take seriously. The Board has disciplined supervisors who have not taken these responsibilities seriously and paid the consequences. If you are supervising Physician Assistants or are planning to supervise one, some of the responsibilities attached to that privilege are listed below. For a complete list, go to our website, www.wvbdosteo.org.

- 1) Supervising physician is responsible for observing, directing and evaluating the work, records and practices performed by the physician assistant and is legally responsible for the practice of the PA at all times;
- 2) Supervising physician may not permit a physician assistant to practice independently, maintain an independent place of practice, or practice outside the scope of the board-approved privileges;
- 3) Constant physical presence of the physician is not required as long as the supervising physician and physician assistant are, or can be, easily in contact with one another by electronic communication;
- 4) NCCPA certification is a requirement for all licensed PA's. If that certification is lost by non-renewal at the end of the calendar year due, the PA's license is automatically expired. They have no license to practice and the Supervising Physician MUST not allow them to continue to see patients;
- 5) Personal and regular review, at least monthly, by the Supervising Physician of selected patient records with PA involvement. The chart review shall be sufficient in number to assure adequate review of the PA's scope of practice. This must occur monthly for the first six months of the Practice Agreement and quarterly thereafter with written documentation of the meeting;
- 6) Only alternate supervisors named within the Practice Agreement can serve as a supervisor to the PA when the primary supervising physician is absent;
- 7) If a Practice Agreement or Contract is terminated between a PA and the Supervising Physician, BOTH must contact the Board within ten (10) days.

NEW ONLINE CME FOR REQUIRED 3 HOUR CME ON PAIN PRESCRIBING

The West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine has joined with WVOMA, WVMA, WV Board of Medicine and the Appalachian Addiction and Prescription Drug Abuse Conference to provide a new online, 3 hour CME on pain prescribing. It is a condensed version of the September 2015 Appalachian Addiction and Prescription Drug Abuse Conference held in Charleston at the Embassy Suites. RECOGNIZING SIGNS AND BEHAVIORS OF POTENTIAL PHYSICIAN IMPAIRMENT

A free web course for doctors and nurses on recognizing the signs and behaviors of potential impairment is now available. Go to www.wvmp.org to learn the identification and management process with healthcare professionals who exhibit these behaviors and how you can help them get the help they need. Under §24-6-5.2.5 of the Rules of the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine, any individual having reason to believe that the conduct of licensee amounts to professional incompetence shall be encouraged to report the information to the Board.

CHANGES TO THE LAW WITH THE LICENSING OF PAIN CLINICS

The required licensing of Pain Management Clinics began July 1, 2014. If your practice meets the definition of a Pain Clinic, you **MUST** apply with OHFLAC through WV Department of Human and Health Services for a license to continue their current practice of medicine in the State. The contact person at OHFLAC is Sylvia Fields, Program Manager (304) 558-0050.

If you meet the requirements but do not apply for a license, OHFLAC will report that to the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine and the Board will open a complaint. If you are unsure whether you meet the requirements, contact the Board Office or OHFLAC.

Pain Clinic Definition:

Privately owned clinic, facility or office where more than fifty percent (50%) of patients of the clinic are prescribed or dispensed opioids or other controlled substances specified in rules promulgated pursuant to this article for chronic pain resulting from conditions that are not terminal.

Chronic Pain Definition:

Pain that has persisted after reasonable medical efforts have been made to relieve the pain or cure its cause and that has continued, either continuously or episodically, for longer than three (3) continuous months. For purposes of this article, "chronic pain" does not include pain directly associated with a terminal condition.
