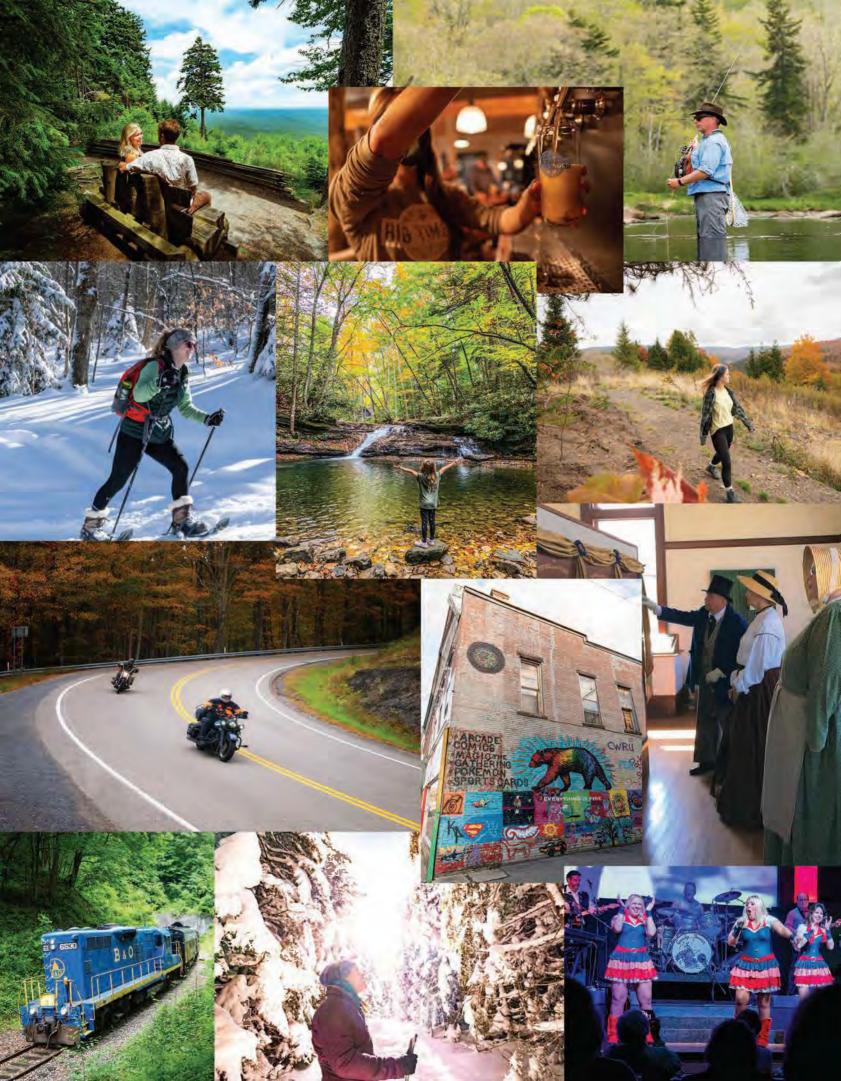

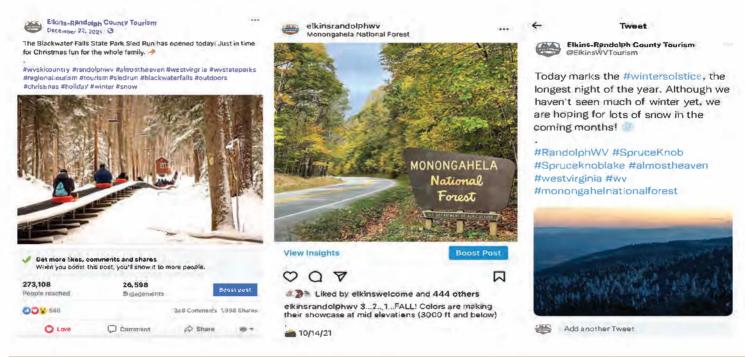








Our combined social media platforms and website traffic have seen a substantial increase of followers and visitations. We have recieved more than 3 million impressions in 2021.

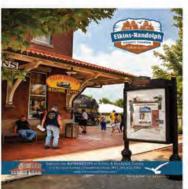

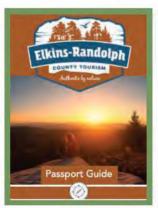


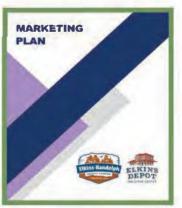

INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REVIEW REPORT

To the Board of Directors: Elkins Depot Welcome Center CVB, Inc. Elkins, WV 26241

We have reviewed the accompanying financial statements of Elkins Depot Welcome Center CVB, Inc. (a nonprofit organization), which comprise the statement of assets, liabilities, and net assets – cash basis as of June 30, 2022, and the related statement of revenues, expenses and changes in net assets – cash basis for the year then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements. A review includes primarily applying analytical procedures to management's financial data and making inquiries of management. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit, the objective of which is the expression of an opinion regarding the financial statements as whole. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion.

Those standards require us to perform procedures to obtain limited assurance as a basis for reporting whether we are aware of any material modifications that should be made to the financial statements for them to be in accordance with the cash basis of accounting. We believe that the results of our procedures provide a reasonable basis for our conclusion.

We are required to be independent of Elkins Depot Welcome Center CVB, Inc. and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements related to our review.

Accountant's Conclusion

Based on our review, we are not aware of any material modifications that should be made to the accompanying financial statements in order for them to be in accordance with the cash basis of accounting.

Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note A of the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared in accordance with the cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our conclusion is not modified with respect to this matter.

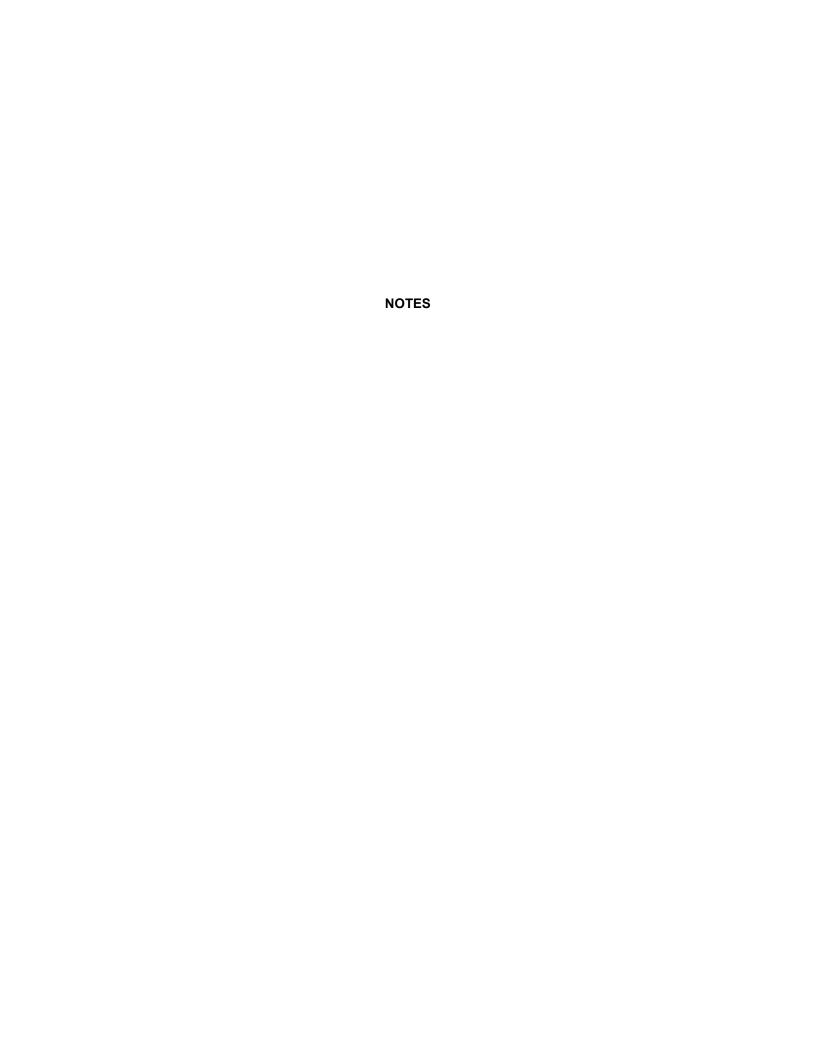

ELKINS DEPOT WELCOME CENTER CVB, INC. NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2022

I. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Elkins Depot Welcome Center CVB, Inc. is a private, nonprofit organization governed by a volunteer board of directors comprised of members of the community who assume overall responsibility and Company for the efficient operation of the center in relation to its goals, which are to promote Elkins and the surrounding area with the purpose of increasing economic vitality in entities related to tourism recreation while providing excellent service to visitors.

Measurement Focus, Basis of Accounting, and Financial Statement Presentation

The Company's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting; consequently, certain revenues are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses and purchases of assets are recognized when cash is disbursed rather than when the obligation is incurred.

Estimates

Management uses estimates and assumptions in preparing financial statements. Those estimates and assumptions affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities, and the reported revenues and expenses. Actual results could differ from these estimates.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

The Company considers all highly liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less and amounts receivable from credit card companies to be cash equivalents.

Investments

The Company records investments at cost, or if donated, at fair value on the date of donation. Thereafter, investments are reported at their fair values in the statement of assets, liabilities and assets. Net investment return (loss) is reported in the statement of revenues, expenses, and change in net assets and consists of interest and dividend income, realized and unrealized capital gains and losses, less investment management, and custodial fees.

Capital Assets and Depreciation

Capital assets are reported at cost for purchased items and at fair value for contributed items. Deprecation is computed by the straight-line method based on estimated service lives of the assets. The Company's policy is to capitalize assets whose expended useful life is in excess of one year and cost (or fair value) is above an estimated threshold of \$2,500.

The estimated useful lives of the assets are as follows:

Furniture and equipment 5 to 15 years Buildings and Leasehold improvements 15 to 39 years

Maintenance, repairs, and minor renewals are charged to operations as incurred. Additions, improvements, and major renewals are capitalized. The cost of assets, retired or sold, together with their related accumulated depreciation, are removed from the accounts and any gain or loss on disposition is credited or charged to operations.

Grant Revenue

The Company receives financial assistance from various state and local governmental agencies in the form of grants. The disbursement of funds received under these programs generally requires compliance with terms and conditions specified in the grant agreements and is subject to audit by the grantor. Any disallowed claims resulting from such audits would become a liability of the Company. Based on proper experience, the Company's administration believes such disallowances, if any, would be immaterial.

Net Assets

Net investment in capital assets – This amount consists of capital assets net of accumulated depreciation and reduced by outstanding debt that attributed to the acquisition, construction, or improvement of the assets.

Restricted net position – This amount is restricted by external creditors, grantors, contributors, or laws and regulations of other governments.

Unrestricted net position – This amount is all net assets that do not meet the definition of "invested in capital assets, net of related debt" or "restricted net assets."

II. CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

As of June 30, 2022, cash and cash equivalents were \$107,392.

Custodial credit risk is the risk that in the event of a bank failure, the government's deposits may not be returned. The Company's deposits on June 30, 2022, were entirely covered by federal depository insurance or secured by adequate bond or other securities held by the banking institution in the Company's name.

IV. GRANTS

The Company receives financial assistance from state and local governmental agencies in the form of grants. The disbursements of funds received under these programs generally require compliance with terms and conditions specified in the grant agreements and subject to audit by the grantor. Any disallowed claims resulting from such audits would become a liability of the Company. Based on prior experience, the Company's administration believes such disallowance, if any, would be immaterial. At June 30, 2022, the Company received grants in the amount of \$5,033.

V. RISK MANAGEMENT AND CONTINGENCIES

The Company is exposed to various risks of losses related to torts; theft of, damage to, and destruction of assets; errors and omissions; natural disasters. The Company carries umbrella (general liability) insurance for these various risks.

The Company provides insurance coverage to employees for job-related injuries through The Hartford Insurance Company.

VI. INCOME TAX

Elkins Depot Welcome Center CVB, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization and is exempt from federal and state income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The letter of exemption is dated July 2, 2019.

VII. SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

In preparing the financial statements, the Company had evaluated events and any transactions for potential recognition or disclosure through September 16, 2022, the date the financial statements were issued.
