Per W. Va. Code §18-30-10(a)(2), the Board of Trustees of the West Virginia College and Jumpstart Savings Programs is hereby submitting to the West Virginia Legislative Librarian the quarterly status report for the quarter ending December 31, 2025, including the trust fund and the administrative account.

§18-30-7 Savings Plan Trust Fund

Assets of the Savings Plan Trust are held in trust for account owners and beneficiaries and do not constitute public funds. During the quarter, the SMART529 Savings Plan added 1,553 accounts, ending the period with 107,406 active nationwide accounts. The assets are valued at \$3,280,526,181. Of the nationwide accounts, 40,860 are West Virginia resident accounts with a total value of \$953,931,510.

§18-30-8 College and Jumpstart Savings Administrative Account

The Administrative Account established in the State Treasurer’s Office is used for the purpose of implementing, operating, and maintaining the Trust Funds and the Programs. The activity in the Administrative Account for the quarter is as follows:

§18-30-13 Prepaid Tuition Trust Escrow Fund

The Prepaid Tuition Trust Escrow Fund was continued in the State Treasury to guarantee payment of outstanding obligations of the Prepaid Tuition Plan arising after the plan’s closure on September 30, 2021. As of December 31, 2025, the balance of the Escrow Fund is \$1,183,107.

§18-30A-8 West Virginia Jumpstart Savings Program Trust

The West Virginia Jumpstart Savings Program Trust opened to the public on July 1, 2022. Assets of the West Virginia Jumpstart Savings Program Trust are held in trust for account owners and beneficiaries and do not constitute public funds. Effective October 1, 2025, the Jumpstart Savings Program started using a new system with a recordkeeper (Catalis), and began investing the participant funds in the Board of Treasury Investment’s West Virginia Money Market Pool. The Jumpstart Savings Program ended the period with 134 accounts, which include accounts still open at United Bank and new accounts opened through Catalis. The assets in trust at the end of the quarter totaled \$46,195. As of December 31, 2025, the balance of the Jumpstart Savings Trust Fund is \$2,006,785.

Community Outreach

SMART529 Savings:

In October, Treasurer Pack kicked off the 19th annual When I Grow Up Essay Contest at Eastbrook Elementary in Putnam County. Nearly 2,000 Kindergarten through Fifth Grade students entered the contest. Twenty-seven teachers entered the teacher portion of the essay contest. Winners to be notified in February. Program sponsorships included the Above & Beyond teacher recognition program and WVU football and basketball. Bright Babies \$100 incentive postcards were mailed to over 3,354 West Virginia families with newborns.
