[Passed March 3, 1994; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section forty-eight, article three, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to exempting the division of natural resources and the division of forestry from travel rules and regulations in the purchasing division.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section forty-eight, article three, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 3. PURCHASING DIVISION.**

**§5A-3-48. Travel rules and regulations; exceptions.**

1     The secretary of administration shall promulgate  
2     rules and regulations relating to the ownership, pur-  
3     chase, use, storage, maintenance and repair of all motor  
4     vehicles and aircraft owned by the state of West  
5     Virginia and in the possession of any department,  
6     institution or agency thereof: *Provided*, That the  
7     provisions of sections forty-eight through fifty-three of  
8     this article shall not apply to the division of highways  
9     of the department of transportation, the division of  
10    public safety of the department of public safety, the

11 division of natural resources of the department of  
12 commerce, labor and environmental resources, the  
13 division of forestry and the department of agriculture.  
14 If, in the judgment of the secretary, economy or  
15 convenience indicate the expediency thereof, the secre-  
16 tary may require all vehicles and the aircraft subject to  
17 regulation by this article, or such of them as he or she  
18 may designate, to be kept in such garages, and other  
19 places of storage, and to be made available in such  
20 manner and under such terms for the official use of such  
21 departments, institutions, agencies, officers, agents and  
22 employees of the state as the secretary may designate  
23 by any such rule or regulation as he or she may from  
24 time to time promulgate. The secretary also has the  
25 authority to administer the travel regulations promul-  
26 gated by the governor in accordance with section eleven,  
27 article three, chapter twelve of this code, unless  
28 otherwise determined by the governor.
