AN ACT to amend and reenact section ten, article one, chapter fifty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to modifying the fees charged by the clerk of the county commission; combining fees charged for various types of documents and services; and increasing certain fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section ten, article one, chapter fifty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. FEES AND ALLOWANCES.

§59-1-10. Fees to be charged by clerk of county commission.

1 For the purpose of this section, the word "page" is
2 defined as being a paper writing of not more than legal
3 size, 8 ½" x 14".

4 The clerk of the county commission shall charge and
5 collect the following fees:

6 (a) When a writing is admitted to record, for receiving
7 proof of acknowledgment thereof, entering an order in
8 connection therewith, endorsing clerk's certificate of
9 recordation thereon and indexing in a proper index, where
10 the writing is a:

11 (1) Deed of conveyance (with or without a plat), trust
12 deed, fixture filing or security agreement concerning real
13 estate lease \$10.00

14 (2) Financing, continuation, termination or other
15 statement or writing permitted to be filed under chapter
16 forty-six of this code 10.00

17 (3) Plat or map (with no deed of conveyance) ... 10.00

18 (4) Service discharge record No Charge

19 (5) Any document or writing other than those refer-
20 enced in subdivisions (1), (2), (3) and (4) of this sub-
21 section 5.00

22 (6) If any document or writing contains more than five
23 pages, for each additional page 1.00

24 (b) For administering any oath other than oaths by
25 officers and employees of the state, political subdivisions
26 of the state, or a public or quasi public entity of the state
27 or a political subdivision of the state, taken in his or her
28 official capacity. 5.00

29 (c)(1) For issuance of marriage license and other duties
30 pertaining to the marriage license (including preparation
31 of the application, administrating the oath, registering and
32 recording the license, mailing acknowledgment of minis-

33 ter's return to one of the licensees and notification to a
34 licensee after sixty days of the nonreceipt of the minister's
35 return) 25.00

36 (2) One dollar of the marriage license fee received
37 pursuant to this subsection shall be paid by the county
38 clerk into the state treasury as a state registration fee in
39 the same manner that license taxes are paid into the
40 treasury under article twelve, chapter eleven of this code;

41 (3) Fifteen dollars of the marriage license fee received
42 pursuant to this subsection shall be paid by the county
43 clerk into the state treasury for the family protection
44 shelter support act in the same manner that license taxes
45 are paid into the treasury under article twelve, chapter
46 eleven of this code.



50 than two pages, for each additional page. 1.00

51 (3) For annexing the seal of the commission or clerk to
52 any paper 1.00

54 certificate or marriage license 5.00




