AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article eleven, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended; and to further amend said article by adding thereto a new section, designated section twenty-one, all relating to continuing the human rights commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article eleven, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that said article be further amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section twenty-one, all to read as follows:

ARTICLE 11. HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION.

The commission shall encourage and endeavor to bring about 5 mutual understanding and respect among all racial, 6 religious and ethnic groups within the state and shall 7 strive to eliminate all discrimination in employment and places of public accommodations by virtue of race, reli-8 gion, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, age, blindness or 9 handicap and shalls trive to eliminate all discrimination in 10 the sale, purchase, lease, rental or financing of housing 11 and other real property by virtue of race, religion, color, 12national origin, ancestry, sex, blindness, handicap or 1314 familial status.

§5-11-21. Termination of commission.

1 The human rights commission shall terminate on the 2 first day of July, two thousand seven, pursuant to the 3 provisions of article ten, chapter four of this code, unless 4 sooner terminated, continued or reestablished pursuant to

5 the provisions of that article.
