AN ACT to amend and reenact section two-b, article two, chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to precinct boundary changes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two-b, article two, chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 2. APPORTIONMENT OF REPRESENTATION.

#### §1-2-2b. Precinct boundary changes.

- 1 If an election precinct of this state includes territory
- 2 contained in more than one senatorial or delegate district,
- 3 as such senatorial districts are established by section one
- 4 of this article and as such delegate districts are established
- 5 by section two of this article, the county commission of the
- 6 county in which the precinct is located shall, prior to the
- 7 fifteenth day of March, two thousand two, alter the
- 8 boundary lines of its election precincts so that no precinct
- 9 contains territory included in more than one senatorial or
- 10 delegate district.
