AN ACT to amend article three, chapter twenty-eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-b, relating to clarifying that venue for criminal or civil actions occurring on the grounds at the West Virginia Industrial home for youth shall be in Harrison County, West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article three, chapter twenty-eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-b, to read as follows:
