AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article five-e, chapter twenty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the equal pay commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, article five-e, chapter twenty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5E. EQUAL PAY FOR EQUAL WORK FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

§21-5E-5. Establishment of the equal pay commission; appointment of members; and expiration date.

1 (a) The equal pay commission is continued. The commis-
2 sion shall be composed of the following seven members:

3 (1) Two members of the House of Delegates, appointed
4 by the speaker;

5 (2) Two members of the Senate, appointed by the
6 president; and

7 (3) Three state employee representatives, including one
8 labor union member representing state employees, as
9 agreed to by the speaker and president; the director of the
10 women's commission, or his or her designee; and the
11 director of the office of equal employment opportunity, or
12 his or her designee.

13 (b) The commission shall seek input from and invite the
14 commissioner of labor or his or her designee and the
15 director of the personnel division of the department of
16 administration or his or her designee to attend meetings of
17 the commission.

18 (c) One of the members of the Senate and one of the
19 members of the House of Delegates, as designated by the
20 president and the speaker respectively, shall serve as
21 cochair of the commission.

22 (d) The members of the House of Delegates, the members
23 of the Senate and the state employee representative
24 members shall be appointed to serve two-year terms.

25 (e) Any member whose term has expired shall serve until
26 his or her successor has been duly appointed. Any person
27 appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve only for the unex-
28 pired term. Any member is eligible for reappointment.

29 (f) Any vacancies occurring in the membership of the
30 commission shall be filled in the same manner as the
31 original appointment for the position being vacated. The
32 vacancy shall not affect the power of the remaining
33 members to execute the duties of the commission.

34 (g) The commission expires on the first day of July, two
35 thousand ten.

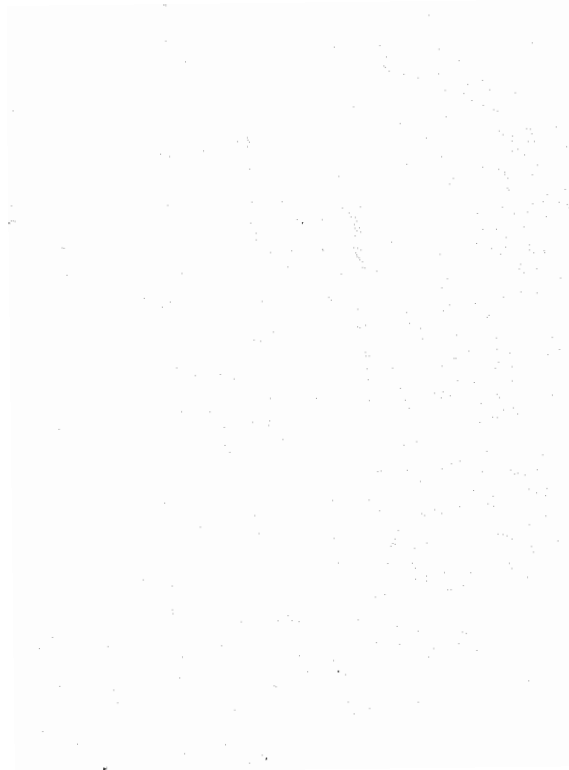
