

AN ACT to amend and reenact section seventeen, article five, chapter twenty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuation of the office of judges.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seventeen, article five, chapter twenty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 5. REVIEW.

#### §23-5-17. Continuation of office of judges.

- 1 The office of judges shall continue to exist, pursuant to the
- 2 provisions of article ten, chapter four of this code, until the first
- 3 day of July, two thousand four, unless sooner terminated,
- 4 continued or reestablished pursuant to the provisions of that
- 5 article.
