That article twenty-seven, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section seventeen, to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 27. BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS.**

**§30-27-17. Continuation of board.**

1 The board of barbers and cosmetologists shall continue  
2 to exist, pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter  
3 four of this code, until the first day of July, two thousand  
4 eight, unless sooner terminated, continued or reestablished  
5 pursuant to the provisions of that article.
