AN ACT to amend and reenact §22-3A-11 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuation of the office of explosives and blasting.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §22-3A-11 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3A. OFFICE OF EXPLOSIVES AND BLASTING.

§22-3A-11. Continuation of office.

- 1 The office of explosives and blasting shall continue to
- 2 exist until the first day of July, two thousand six, unless
- 3 sooner terminated, continued or reestablished pursuant to
- 4 the provisions of article ten, chapter four of this code.
