

AN ACT to amend and reenact §12-3-5 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to electronic requisition format approved by the Auditor; and providing that the Auditor may set standards for archiving electronic and paper documents related to requisitions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §12-3-5 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. APPROPRIATIONS, EXPENDITURES AND DEDUCTIONS.

- §12-3-5. When requisition to Auditor sufficient authority for issuing warrant.
 - 1 (a) When an appropriation has been made by law,
 - 2 subject to the order or payable on the requisition of a
 - 3 particular officer, board or person, the order or written

- 4 or electronic requisition is sufficient authority to the
- 5 Auditor to issue a warrant for the same or any party
- 6 thereof.
- 7 (b) The Auditor:
- 8 (1) Shall accept an electronic requisition from
- 9 Marshall University and West Virginia University in an
- 10 unaltered format approved by the Auditor;
- 11 (2) May accept or require an electronic requisition
- 12 from any entity other than Marshall University or West
- 13 Virginia University at his or her discretion in an
- 14 unaltered format approved by the Auditor; and
- 15 (3) May not issue a warrant for an amount that
- 16 exceeds the appropriation or for an expired
- 17 appropriation.
