

## Senate Bill No. 505

(SENATORS TOMBLIN, MR. PRESIDENT, HUNTER, FOSTER, LOVE, KESSLER, BOLEY, MCKENZIE, JENKINS, PLYMALE, WELLS, UNGER, MINARD, BAILEY, SYPOLT AND EDGELL, original sponsors)

[Passed March 4, 2008; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated

Enr. Com. Sub. for Com. Sub. for S. B. No. 505] 2

§9A-1-11a; and to amend and reenact §29-22-9a of said code, all relating to creating the Veterans Cemetery Fund for the construction and operation of veterans' cemeteries; and authorizing the appropriation of proceeds from the veterans instant lottery scratch-off game to the fund.

#### Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §9A-1-11a; and that §29-22-9a of said code be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

#### CHAPTER 9A. VETERANS' AFFAIRS.

#### ARTICLE 1. DIVISION OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS.

### §9A-1-11a. Establishment of Veterans Cemetery Fund.

- 1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special
- 2 revenue fund to be designated and known as the
- 3 Veterans Cemetery Fund which shall consist of excess
- 4 revenues derived from the veterans instant lottery
- 5 scratch-off game as appropriated to the fund by the
- 6 Legislature and all interest or other returns earned
- 7 from investment of the fund. Funds may also be
- 8 derived from any gift, grant, bequest, endowed fund or
- 9 donation which may be received by any veterans
- 10 cemetery created by statute from any governmental
- 11 entity or unit or any person, firm, foundation or
- 12 corporation. Any balance, including accrued interest or
- other earnings, in this special fund at the end of any
- 14 fiscal year shall not revert to the General Revenue Fund
- 15 but shall remain in the fund.

## CHAPTER 29. MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND OFFICERS.

#### ARTICLE 22. STATE LOTTERY ACT.

#### §29-22-9a. Veterans instant lottery scratch-off game.

- 1 (a) Beginning the first day of September, two
- 2 thousand, the commission shall establish an instant
- 3 lottery scratch-off game designated as the veterans
- 4 benefit game, which is offered by the lottery.
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section eighteen
- 6 of this article, all net profits received from the sale of
- veterans benefit game lottery tickets, materials and 7
- games are deposited with the State Treasurer into the 8
- 9 Veterans Lottery Fund created under subsection (c) of
- this section. The Legislature may make appropriations 10
- from this fund for operational costs from moneys 11
- remaining in the Veterans Lottery Fund after the 12
- acquisition, design, construction, equipping, furnishing, 13
- including, without limitation, the payment of debt 14
- service on bonds issued to finance the foregoing, have 15
- been paid. Funds from the Veterans Lottery Fund for 16 17 the acquisition, design, construction, equipping,

- furnishing, including, without limitation, the payment
- of debt service on bonds issued to finance the 19
- construction of a veterans nursing home and/or 20
- veterans cemetery, shall be transferred to the Veterans 21
- 22 Nursing Home Building Fund and the Veterans

- the Division of Veterans Affairs to the investment 24
- 25 management board and the State Treasurer in
- 26 accordance with the provisions of this section. Once the

29 costs associated with construction are paid in full for 30 the construction and operation of the initial veterans skilled nursing facility or veterans cemetery, the 31 32 Legislature may appropriate from the fund created 33 under this section moneys for the construction, 34 including the architectural fees and other associated costs, equipping and operation of additional skilled 35 36 nursing facilities and/or cemeteries for veterans of the 37 armed forces of the United States military: Provided, 38 That addition to the payment of the 39 above-mentioned items, funds may be deposited in the 40 Veterans Cemetery Fund created in section eleven-a. 41 article one, chapter nine-a of this code and, thereafter, 42 the Legislature may appropriate any excess funds to the 43 General Revenue Fund.

- (c) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special revenue fund designated and known as the Veterans Lottery Fund which shall consist of all revenues derived from the veterans benefit game and any appropriations to the fund by the Legislature and all interest or other returns earned from investment of the fund.
- 51 (d) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 52 special revenue fund designated and known as the 53 Veterans Nursing Home Building Fund which shall 54 consist of all funds for the acquisition, design, 55 construction, equipping, furnishing, including, without limitation, the payment of debt service on bonds issued 56 57 to finance the foregoing. Following the selection of the 58 architect, the director shall certify the estimated total cost of the architect and all construction and associated 59 costs to the Joint Committee on Government and 60 61 Finance prior to the transfer of funds for construction.

If funds transferred exceed the estimated costs certified to the joint committee, the director shall certify the additional costs to the joint committee.

(e) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special revenue fund designated and known as the Veterans Nursing Home Debt Service Fund to which the required funding from the Veterans Nursing Home Building Fund is transferred to refund revenue bonds to pay the principal, interest, redemption premium and coverage ratio requirement, if any, on the revenue bonds issued under the provisions of section seven, article twenty-nine-a, chapter sixteen of this code. The Veterans Nursing Home Debt Service Fund has first priority to all funds in the Veterans Nursing Home Building Fund established herein not otherwise designated or specified by the donor. Beginning on or before the twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand three, and continuing until the twenty-eighth day of June, two thousand thirty-five, the Treasurer shall allocate to the Veterans Nursing Home Debt Service Fund from the Veterans Nursing Home Building Fund, as a first priority, an amount equal to one tenth of the projected annual principal, interest, redemption premium and coverage ratio requirement on any and all revenue bonds and refunding bonds issued, or to be issued, on or after the first day of July, two thousand three, under the provisions of said section in connection with a veterans nursing home as certified to the Treasurer and the Investment Management Board by the Director of the Division of Veterans Affairs. In the event there are insufficient funds available in any month to transfer the amount required pursuant to this subsection to the Veterans Nursing Home Debt Service Fund, the deficiency shall be added to the amount

- 98 (f) The commission shall change the design or theme
- 99 of the veterans benefit game regularly so that the game
- 100 remains competitive with the other instant lottery
- 101 scratch-off games offered by the commission. The
- 102 tickets for the instant lottery game created in this
- section shall clearly state that the profits derived from
- the game are being used to benefit veterans in this state.
