9 A BILL supplementing, amending and increasing items of the existing
10 appropriations from the State Road Fund to the Department of
11 Transportation - Division of Highways, fund 9017, fiscal year
12 2012, organization 0803, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
13 2012.

14 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature a statement
15 of the State Road Fund, dated August 1, 2011, setting forth therein
16 the cash balances and investments as of July 1, 2011, and further
17 included the estimate of revenues for the fiscal year 2012, less
18 net appropriation balances forwarded and regular appropriations for
19 the fiscal year 2012; and

20 WHEREAS, It appears from the Statement of the State Road Fund
21 there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury
22 which is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending
23 June 30, 2012; therefore

24 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the items of the total appropriations from the State Road
 2 Fund to the Department of Transportation - Division of Highways,
 3 fund 9017, fiscal year 2012, organization 0803, be supplemented and
 4 amended by increasing existing items of appropriation as follows:
