19.	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
20	That $\$2-2-1a$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,

222	ARTICLE 2. LEGAL HOLIDAYS; SPECIAL MEMORIAL DAYS; CONSTRUCTION OF
23	STATUTES; DEFINITIONS.
24	§2-2-1a. Special memorial days.

- 1 (a) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare the week 2 beginning with the Sunday before Thanksgiving as a special memorial 3 week to be known as Native American Indian Heritage Week.
- 4 (b) The first Tuesday after the first Monday of November is 5 designated Susan B. Anthony Day and shall only be a legal holiday 6 in all years ending in an even number. The Governor shall annually 7 issue a proclamation calling on all schools, civic organizations, 8 government departments and citizens to undertake activities on the 9 designated day and surrounding days to pay tribute to the 10 accomplishments of Susan B. Anthony in securing the civil and 11 political rights of all Americans, including securing equal voting 12 rights for women.
- (c) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare the week 14 during which December 7 falls to be a special memorial week, to be 15 known as Pearl Harbor and Military Appreciation week, honoring all 16 West Virginians who fought in World War II and all other military 17 conflicts and shall encourage all municipalities in the state to do 18 the same. The State Department of Education is directed to 19 implement a program involving activities in which students shall 20 participate which shall recognize the contributions West Virginians 21 have made to their country through service in the United States 22 military.
- NOTE: The purpose of the bill is to make the week in which 24 December 7 fall a special memorial week. The bill directs the 25 State Department of Education to develop a program involving 26 students which will educate them about the contributions made by

1 West Virginians in the United States military. 2
