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11	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$18A-3-3a$ of the Code of West Virginia,
12	1931, as amended, relating to reimbursement of tuition,
13	registration and other required fees for course work completed
14	by teachers; limiting reimbursement depending on grade earned;
15	and placing certain limits on number of courses per teacher
16	eligible within certain time period and lifetime.
17	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
18	That §18A-3-3a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
19	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
20	ARTICLE 3. TRAINING, CERTIFICATION, LICENSING, PROFESSIONAL
21	DEVELOPMENT.
22	§18A-3-3a. Payment of tuition, registration and other fees for
23	teachers; maximum payment per teacher.
24	(a) The West Virginia Department of Education shall promulgate
25	rules to administer the reimbursement of tuition, registration and

- 1 other required fees for course work completed by teachers in
- 2 accordance with the provisions of this section. The rules shall
- 3 provide for reimbursement for courses completed toward both
- 4 certification renewal and additional endorsement in a shortage
- 5 area.
- 6 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 7 have the meanings ascribed to them:
- 8 (1) "Teacher" has the meaning provided in section one, article
- 9 one, chapter eighteen of this code.
- 10 (2) "Shortage area" shall be defined by state board policy to
- 11 indicate the subject areas for which an insufficient number of
- 12 teachers are available.
- 13 (3) "Certification" and "certificate" means a valid West
- 14 Virginia:
- 15 (A) Professional teaching, service or administrative
- 16 certificate, or its equivalent; or
- 17 (B) Provisional professional teaching, service or
- 18 administrative certificate, or its equivalent.
- 19 (4) "Requirements for certification renewal" are those
- 20 requirements of the State Department of Education as provided in
- 21 section three of this article.
- 22 (5) "Requirements for additional endorsement" are those
- 23 requirements of the State Department of Education as provided in
- 24 section three of this article.
- 25 (6) "State institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 26 provided in section two, article one, chapter eighteen-b of this

- 1 code.
- 2 (c) To the extent of funds appropriated for the purposes
- 3 specified in this section, payment shall be made to any teacher
- 4 who:
- 5 (1) Holds either a valid West Virginia:
- 6 (A) Certificate; or
- 7 (B) First class permit for full-time employment; and
- 8 (2) Is seeking:
- 9 (A) An additional endorsement in a shortage area, and either
- 10 resides in the state or is employed regularly for instructional
- 11 purposes in a public school in the state; or
- 12 (B) Certification renewal, and has a continuing contract with
- 13 a county board.
- 14 (d) The payment shall be made as reimbursement for the
- 15 tuition, registration and other required fees for any course
- 16 completed at:
- 17 (1) Any college or university within the state; or
- 18 (2) A college or university outside the state if prior
- 19 approval is granted by the department.
- 20 (e) A course is eligible for reimbursement if it meets the
- 21 requirements for:
- 22 (1) An additional endorsement in a shortage area; or
- 23 (2) Certification renewal.
- 24 (f) If funds appropriated for the purposes specified in this
- 25 section are insufficient for the reimbursement of all eligible
- 26 courses within the limits provided in this section, the West

- 1 Virginia Department of Education shall make the reimbursements for
- 2 courses for additional endorsement in a shortage area and
- 3 certification renewal in a shortage area first.
- 4 (q) Payment made for any single fee may not exceed the amount
- 5 of the highest corresponding fee charged at a state institution of
- 6 higher education.
- 7 (h) Reimbursement for courses pursuant to this section shall
- 8 be limited in accordance with the following:
- 9 (1) A teacher who is seeking reimbursement for a course in
- 10 which he or she earned an "A" shall be reimbursed one hundred
- 11 percent;
- 12 (2) A teacher who is seeking reimbursement for a course in
- 13 which he or she earned a "B" shall be reimbursed ninety percent;
- 14 (3) A teacher who is seeking reimbursement for a course in
- 15 which he or she earned a "C" shall be reimbursed eighty percent;
- 16 and
- 17 <u>(4) A teacher who is seeking reimbursement for a course in</u>
- 18 which he or she earned a "D" or "F" may not be reimbursed any
- 19 amount.
- 20 (h) (i) Reimbursement for courses completed toward
- 21 certification renewal is limited to reimbursement for six semester
- 22 hours of courses per teacher per certification renewal period
- 23 subject to a lifetime maximum of fifteen semester hours of courses
- 24 for any teacher. Reimbursement for courses completed toward
- 25 additional endorsement in a shortage area is limited to fifteen
- 26 semester hours of courses for any teacher. Reimbursement for

- 1 courses completed toward certification in a shortage area is
- 2 limited to reimbursement for six semester hours of courses per
- 3 teacher per year, with no lifetime limit.
- 4 (i) (j) The West Virginia Department of Education shall seek
- 5 funding from sources other than general revenue appropriation,
- 6 including, but not limited to, workforce investment funds.
- 7 $\frac{\text{(j)}}{\text{(k)}}$ No provision of this section may be construed to
- 8 require any appropriation or any specific amount of appropriation
- 9 for the purposes specified in this section, or to require the
- 10 department to expend funds for those purposes from any other
- 11 amounts appropriated for expenditure by the department.
